02124	Intellectual Disability	Mental retardation	This refers to significantly subaverage general intellectual functioning, existing concurrently with deficits in adaptive behavior and manifested during the developmental period, which adversely affects a child's educational performance.	A state of significantly below-average general intellectual functioning existing concurrently with deficits in adaptive behavior that is manifested during the developmental period, which adversely affects an individual's educational performance.
02454	Cooling generation system	Cooling system	The type of mechanical systems and building designs used for cooling.	
02455	Air distribution system	Ventilation system	The primary means by which air is circulated, freshened, and exhausted.	
02456	Communications system	Communications management	The types of systems, interface, and management components for carrying voice, video, and data throughout a building.

School counselors may be reported by elementary and secondary level when that information is available.
