1437	Mid-Term Mark	Indicator of student performance at the mid-point of the marking period.
1438	Class Ranking Date	Date class ranking was determined.
1439	Projected Graduation Date	The month and year the student is projected to graduate.
1440	Assessment Administration Begin Date	The month(s), day(s), and year on which an assessment administration began.
1441	Assessment Administration End Date	The month(s), day(s), and year on which an assessment administration ended.
1442	Assessment Form	Form, version or edition of the test.
1443	GPA Weighted Indicator	An indication of whether the reported GPA is weighted or unweighted.
1444	Special Education FTE	Calculated ratio of time the student is in a special ed setting. Values range from 0.00 to 1.00. If the student is in a special ed setting 25% of the time, the value is .25; if 100% of the time, the value is 1.00.
1445	Student Program Status	The current status of the student's program participation.
1446	Gifted Eligibility Criteria	State/local code used to determine eligibility for Gifted/Talented program.
1447	Planned Assessment Participation	The student's planned level of participation in statewide assessments.
1448	Service Category	The type of service, typically designated by a state.
1449	Parent Legal Guardian Indicator	An indication as to whether the individual have parental or legal guardianship responsibility for the student
1450	Pick Up Rights Status	An indicator as to whether or not the contact has pickup rights.
1451	Lives With Status	An indicator as to whether the student lives with this contact.
1452	Access to Records Status	An indicator as to whether this contact has access to the student's records.
1453	Emergency Contact Status	An indicator as to whether this contact should be notified in case of emergency.

1457	Timetable Day Name	The name of the timetable day.
1458	Timetable Period Identifier	The unique identifier for the timetable period for this school calendar.
1459	Timetable Period Name	The name of the timetable period.
1460	Bell Period Start Time	The starting time for the bell period.
1461	Bell Period End Time	The ending time for the bell period.
1462	Regular School Period Status	Indicator of whether the bell period is part of the regular school day (i.e. is not a before or after school or break period).
1463	Instructional Minutes in Period	The number of minutes to be counted for instruction for the bell period.
1464	Period Use in Attendance Calculations	An indicator of whether the bell period should be included in attendance calculations.
1465	Section Count for Attendance	An indicator of whether attendance in this section is collected and used in attendance calculations.
1466	Start Date	The starting date on which information in an instance, school year, or reporting period is applicable.
1467	Start Day	Number of the first school day to which an instance, school year, or reporting period applies.
1468	End Date	The ending date on which information in an instance, school year, or reporting period is applicable.
1469	End Day	Number of the last school day to which an instance, school year, or reporting period applies.
1470	Resident	An indication as to whether or not the student's legal residence was within the boundaries of the school during the time between the Start Date and End Date, inclusive.
1471	Calendar Date Number	The order in which the calendar date falls within the school calendar.

1473	Date Attendance Value	Amount of the school day in which the student should be in attendance.

1475	Item Response	Answer selected or student work in raw format.
1476	Item Response Location	The location of the response or additional response.
1477	Item Response Status	The status of the item response.
1478	Item Response Time	The length of time the student took to respond.
1479	Item Diagnostic Statement	Psychometric purpose or design-related comment about the question.
1480	Item Number of Attempts	The number of times a student changes their answer or attempts a response.
1481	Item Score	The score the student received on the specific item.
1482	Item Aid Set Used	A tool or aid set used while viewing the item
1483	Item Response Type	A value that indicates the response type for the item.
1484	Assessment Item Stimulus	A piece of content to be used by the test taker in responding to the stem.
1485	Assessment Item Stem	The question, task, or statement that prompts a response from the test taker.
1486	Assessment Item Choice Label	A choice number or other identifier for the choice. It may be used to indicate the order or grouping of the choices.
1487	Assessment Item Choice Content	The text of the choice, such as true, 27, or Important economic and social factors.
1488	Assessment Item Choice Credit Value	A numeric value that indicates the amount of credit awarded for choosing the choice.

1503	Learning Standard Statement Code	An alphanumeric Id code as defined by the organization to identify the statement.
1504	Learning Standard Number	This is the specific number of the standard.
1505	Learning Standard Benchmark	The level within the hierarchy or a learning standard that follows the subject area and the standard.
1506	Neglected or Delinquent Participation Total Day Count	The total number of instructional days the student was enrolled in this neglected or delinquent program during this reporting period.
1507	Case Manager	The name of the case manager responsible for the academic plans of this student.
1508	Measurement Statistic Type	The type of statistic or analysis.

1509	Item Scale Value	The value of the Item based on an analysis or statistic.
1510	Minimum Value	The minimum value possible for the measurement and test design.
1511	Maximum Value	The maximum value possible for the measurement and test design.
1512	Optimal Value	The optimal value for this measurement and test design.
1513	Performance Level	The associated performance level of the assessment score results.
1514	School Choice Eligible Status	An indication the student is eligible to transfer for the current school year under the public school choice provisions or who applied and transferred in the current school year under the public school choice provisions or previously applied and transferred under the public school choice provisions and continue to attend the transfer school in the current year.
1515	School Choice Applied Status	An indication the student applied to transfer for the current school year under the public school choice provisions but did not or were unable to transfer or applied and transferred in the current school year under the public school choice provisions or previously applied and transferred under the public school choice provisions and continue to attend the transfer school in the current year.
1516	School Choice Implementation Status	An indication of whether an LEA was not able to implement the provisions for public school choice under Title I, Part A, Section 1116 of ESEA as amended by NCLB.
1517	Construction Year	The year the building was first constructed.
1518	Addition Year	The year the construction on the addition was completed.
1519	Functional Age of Building	The number of years since a comprehensive upgrade of ALL major building systems and components, such that it functions as a modern building.
1520	Building Type	The type of building in which a school is located.
1521	Site Area Type	The designated constructed outdoor area on a public school site.
1522	Basement Excavation	The site work required to create basement spaces under a building.
1523	Basement Walls	The construction of structural vertical faces in the basement of a building.
1524	Environmental or Energy Performance Rating System	An evaluation system that certifies that an appliance, building system or component, building or facility is designed and constructed to improve the following metrics: energy savings, water efficiency, CO2 emissions reduction, improved indoor environmental quality, and stewardship of resources and sensitivity to their impacts.

1525	Commercial Equipment	Food preparation equipment used for warming, cooking, drying, cleaning, freezing, or cooling.
1526	Institutional Equipment	Equipment that is installed for use in support of instructional program such as kilns for art, planetarium equipment for astronomy, fitness equipment for physical education.
1527	Other equipment	Equipment that is installed for special safety reasons, such as fume hoods in the science rooms.
1528	Floor Construction	The horizontal structures spanning the width of the building.
1529	Foundation Type	A part of the substructure of a building upon which the building shell is constructed.
1530	Fixed Furnishings	Furniture which is permanently installed in a space.
1531	Movable Furnishings	Furniture which is not permanently installed in a space and can be relocated by simply carrying it from one location to another.
1532	HVAC System	The building service system that provides for heating, ventilation and air-conditioning.
1533	Interior Ceiling Finish	The type of covering, structural or not, of the interior ceilings.
1534	Fittings	Any machine, component, piping, or tubing part that can attach or connect two or more larger parts.
1535	Interior Doors	A door that closes off rooms within a building.
1536	Partitions	Something that divides or separates, as a wall dividing one room or cubicle from another.
1537	Interior Floor Finish	The type of covering, structural or not, of the interior floors.
1538	Interior Wall Finish	The type of covering, structural or not, of the interior walls.
1539	Mechanical Conveying Systems	Mechanical means for moving people and equipment within buildings.
1540	Roof Construction	The uppermost exterior plane of a building structure.
1541	Stair Construction	The design or structure of stairs.
1542	Stair Finishes	The type of covering, structural or not, of stairs.
1543	Site Electrical Utilities	The exterior site related electrical systems and components.

1544	Site Improvements	Designed and constructed modifications to a site.
1545	Site Preparation	Activities required to physically prepare a site for construction.
1546	Special Construction	Building or component construction that is based on a non-standard design or the result of special conditions--such as excess noise, or seismic conditions.
1547	Staircases	Construction designed to bridge a large vertical distance by dividing it into smaller vertical distances, called steps.
1548	Environmental or Energy Performance Rating Categories	The primary groupings that rating organizations use to evaluate environmental sustainability and energy use.
1549	LEED Eligibility Standards for Alterations and Additions	LEED standards for the level of work in alterations and additions required to be eligible for LEED certification for existing buildings.
1550	Facility Furnishings Type	Moveable assets that are provided so the building or interior assets can be utilized by occupants for their intended purposes.
1551	Capital Project Change Start Date	The revised day, month, year for the start of a capital improvement project.
1552	Capital Project Change Scheduled Completion Date	The revised day, month and year that a capital project is scheduled to be completed such that the owners may safely occupy or use the building, system, or space.
1553	Capital Project Status	The phases of work required to complete a major capital project.
1554	Naturally Occuring Hazard Type	Type of natural hazard that can affect the health, safety and operation of school facilities and their occupants.
1555	Joint Development Type	The type of development where two or more entities partner to plan, site, design, and/or build a new school or renovate an existing school to better support the joint use of the building and/or land.
1556	Charter School Realty Access Type	The type of real estate vehicle throughwhich a public charter school has access and control of its building space.
1557	Joint Use Scheduling Type	The type of designation of non school district users by the amount of time they have access to public school for joint use.
1558	Annual Hours of School Operation-Before School	The number of hours that a building is open before regular school hours for its school related programs and operations over a twelve month period.
1559	Annual Hours of School Operation-Regular School Hours	The number of hours that a building is open during regular school hours for its school related programs and operations over a twelve month period.
1560	Annual Hours of School Operation-After School	The number of hours that a building is open after regular school hours for its school related programs and operations over a twelve month period.

1561	Annual Hours of School Operation-Weekend Hours	The number of hours that a building is open during weekend hours for its school related programs and operations over a twelve month period.
1562	Annual Hours of School Operation-Summer Session	The number of hours that a building is open during the summer session for its school related programs and operations over a twelve month period.
1563	Enrollment Projection Number-Next Year	The number of students that may be assumed to enroll in a school or school system for the next school year.
1564	Enrollment Projection-Start Year	The first school year for which enrollment projections are being developed.
1565	Enrollment Projection-End Year	The last year for which enrollment projections are being developed-typically 5 to 10 years for school facility planning.
1566	Joint User Type	The types of users sharing school district controlled, owned, or utilized facilities.
1567	Joint Use Rationale	The reasons for permitting and participating in joint-use.
1568	Financing Fee Type	The type of fee that one must pay when getting a mortgage.
1569	Lease Amount Category (Facilities)	The category of payment that a school must pay to rent the facility that it is in.
1570	Lease Amount (Facilities)	The amount of money the school must pay to rent the facility that it is in.
1571	Lease Type (Facility)	The type of agreement that allows the use and possession of a school, building, or other facility from a third party in return for a regularly scheduled installment payment over an agreed-upon period.
1572	Charter School Location Duration	An indication of permanency that a public charter school will be in a location.
1573	Mortgage Interest Amount	The amount the borrower pays the lender to compensate the lender for the use of money to purchase a building or facility.
1574	Mortgage Interest Type	The type of interest paid on a mortgage to the lender to compensate the lender for the use of money to purchase a building or facility.
1575	Mortgage Type	The status of a mortgage as it relates to priority of payment.
1576	Other Debt Type	Other types of borrowing instruments.
1577	Revenue from Community Service Activities Type	Revenue from community service activities operated by a school district. For example, revenue received from a skating facility by a school district as a community service would be recorded in account code 1800. Multiple accounts may be established within the 1800 series to differentiate various activities.

1578	Prior to Secondary Course Identifier	The five-digit SCED code and name of the course. The first two-digits of the code represent the Prior to Secondary Course Subject Area. Courses within a Subject Area are distinguished by a three-digit code. The codes carry no meaning within themselves. These identifiers are fairly general but provide enough specificity to identify the course's topic and to distinguish it from other courses in that subject area.
1579	Incident Time Description Code	A code for the description of the time of day that an incident took place.
1580	Multiple Offense Designation	An indication of whether the offense was primary or secondary in nature when a single incident included more than one type of offense.
1581	Incident Witness Type	Information on the type of individual who witnessed the incident. A `witness` is an individual who can give a firsthand account of an incident that was seen, heard, or experienced.
1582	Witness ID	Identifies the witness of the incident by use of a pre-existing unique identifier assigned to a student or staff member by a school or district.
1583	IEP Placement Meeting Convened	An indication as to whether an offense and/or disciplinary action resulted in a meeting of a student's Individualized Education Program (IEP) team to determine appropriate placement.
