

Errata notice

Highlights From TIMSS 2011: Mathematics and Science Achievement of U.S. Fourth- and Eighth-Grade Students in an International Context (NCES 2013-009) and supplemental tables.

Since the report and supplemental tables were released on December 11, 2012, the following changes have been made and are now reflected in the PDFs available for viewing and downloading.

Report: Table 1 inadvertently omitted two countries that participated in previous rounds of TIMSS but that did not participate in 2011: Bulgaria and Switzerland. The Note for figures with race/ethnicity data incorrectly stated that the category “Asian includes Pacific Islander and Native Hawaiian.” The category Asian does not include any other race/ethnicities. Footnote 6 in Figure 1 and 9 incorrectly listed Azerbaijan when Azerbaijan was not a trend country at grade 4. Lastly, some of the links printed below tables and figures in the report to take readers to the standard error tables in Appendix E inadvertently included a typo (directing users to “pubsinfor.asp?” instead of “pubsinfo.asp?”). All of these errors have been corrected.

Appendix A: On page A-4, the text incorrectly stated that the TIMSS 2011 sampling frame was based on the 2010 National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) school sampling frame. It was based on the 2011 NAEP school sampling frame. This has been corrected in the text and in footnote 7.

Appendix E: In the Standard Error tables, the footnotes that incorrectly listed Azerbaijan when Azerbaijan was not a trend country at grade 4 have been corrected. In addition, the Notes under tables with race/ethnicity data, which incorrectly stated that the category “Asian includes Pacific Islander and Native Hawaiian,” have been corrected.
