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SY 2013-14 Virtual School Flag

- Definition - A public school that offers only instruction in which students and teachers are separated by time and/or location, and interaction occurs via computers and/or telecommunications technologies. A virtual school generally does not have a physical facility that allows students to attend classes on site.
- The permitted values :
 - Yes
 - No
- Results:
 - 2013-14 – 5 states were non-respondent
 - 2014-15 – 2 states still non-respondent

SY 2016-17 Virtual School Flag

- Definition - An indication of the extent to which a public school offers instruction in which students and teachers are separated by time and/or location, and interaction occurs via computers and/or telecommunications technologies.
- The permitted values :
 - Full Virtual – The school has no physical building where students meet with each other or with teachers, all instruction is virtual.
 - Virtual with Face to Face Options – The school focuses on a systematic program of virtual instruction but includes some physical meetings among students or with teachers.
 - Supplemental Virtual – The school offers virtual courses but virtual instruction is not the primary means of instruction.
 - Not Virtual – The school does not offer any virtual instruction
