<sup>1</sup> For degree-granting institutions that have 15 or more full-time staff members, “Postsecondary Teachers” are reported by the following functions: Instruction; Instruction combined with research and/or public service; Research; and Public Service.

For all other institutions, “Postsecondary Teachers” are reported in the single category. Also, full-time instructional staff is a sub-set of “Postsecondary Teachers” are includes the following two functions: 1) Instruction and 2) Instruction combined with research and/or public service.

<sup>2</sup> Only degree-granting institutions report Graduate Assistants (GAs). In addition to the GA – Teaching category, GAs are also reported separately by the following categories: Research; Management; Business and Financial Operations; Computer, Engineering, and Science; Community Service, Legal, Arts, and Media; Library and Instructional Support; and Healthcare Practitioners and Technical.

<sup>3</sup> For degree-granting institutions that have 15 or more full-time staff members, library-related occupations are reported separately as: Archivists, Curators, and Museum Technicians; Librarians; and Library Technicians. For all other institutions, library-related occupations are reported in the single category called “Librarians, Curators, and Archivists.”

NOTE: Military specific occupations (SOC code 55-0000) are part of the SOC system, but are not applicable to the IPEDS HR survey because IPEDS HR collects data on civilian staff.
