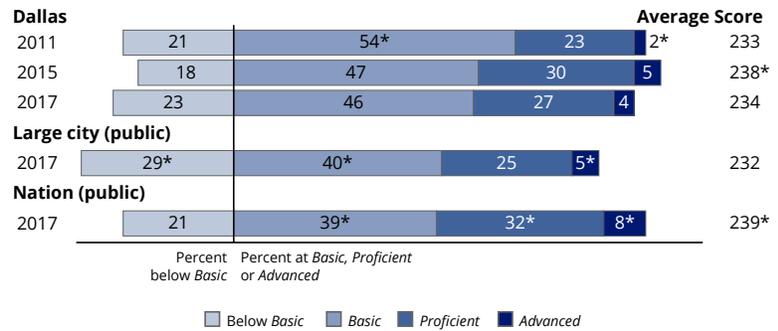


## Overall Results

- In 2017, the average score of fourth-grade students in Dallas was 234. This was not significantly different from the average score of 232 for public school students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Dallas in 2017 (234) was lower than their average score in 2015 (238) and was not significantly different from their average score in 2011 (233).
- The percentage of students in Dallas who performed at or above the NAEP *Proficient* level was 31 percent in 2017. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2015 (34 percent) and was greater than that in 2011 (25 percent).
- The percentage of students in Dallas who performed at or above the NAEP *Basic* level was 77 percent in 2017. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2015 (82 percent) and in 2011 (79 percent).

## Achievement-Level Percentages and Average Score Results



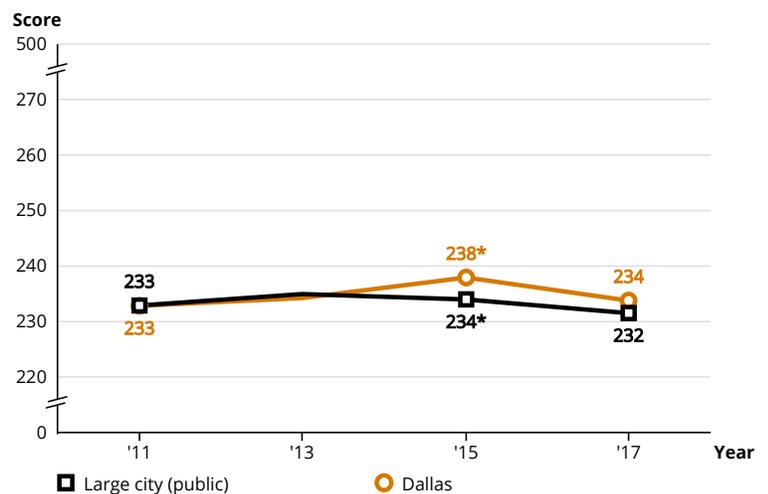

## Score Gaps for Student Groups

- In 2017, Hispanic students had an average score that was 13 points higher than that for Black students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2011 (9 points).
- In 2017, male students in Dallas had an average score that was not significantly different from that for female students.
- Data are not reported for students who were not eligible for free/reduced-price school lunch in 2017, because reporting standards were not met.
