


Overall Results

- In 2019, the average score of eighth-grade students in Guilford County (NC) was 280. This was higher than the average score of 274 for students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Guilford County (NC) in 2019 (280) was higher than their average score in 2017 (276).
- The percentage of students in Guilford County (NC) who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 33 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (31 percent).
- The percentage of students in Guilford County (NC) who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 67 percent in 2019. This percentage was higher than that in 2017 (61 percent).

NAEP Achievement-Level Percentages and Average Score Results





Score Gaps for Student Groups

- In 2019, Black students had an average score that was 39 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (34 points).
- In 2019, Hispanic students had an average score that was 25 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was narrower than that in 2017 (37 points).
- In 2019, male students in Guilford County (NC) had an average score that was not significantly different from that for female students.
- In 2019, students who were eligible for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), had an average score that was 34 points lower than that for students who were not eligible. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (32 points).
