


### Overall Results

- In 2019, the average score of eighth-grade students in Hillsborough County was 276. This was not significantly different from the average score of 274 for students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Hillsborough County in 2019 (276) was not significantly different from their average score in 2017 (277) and was lower than their average score in 2011 (282).
- The percentage of students in Hillsborough County who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 29 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (29 percent) and in 2011 (32 percent).
- The percentage of students in Hillsborough County who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 63 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (65 percent) and was lower than that in 2011 (72 percent).

### NAEP Achievement-Level Percentages and Average Score Results





### Score Gaps for Student Groups

- In 2019, Black students had an average score that was 34 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2011 (30 points).
- In 2019, Hispanic students had an average score that was 24 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2011 (19 points).
- In 2019, male students in Hillsborough County had an average score that was not significantly different from that for female students.
- In 2019, students who were eligible for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), had an average score that was 37 points lower than that for students who were not eligible. This performance gap was wider than that in 2011 (28 points).
