


### Overall Results

- In 2019, the average score of eighth-grade students in Guilford County (NC) was 258. This was higher than the average score of 255 for students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Guilford County (NC) in 2019 (258) was not significantly different from their average score in 2017 (260).
- The percentage of students in Guilford County (NC) who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 28 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (30 percent).
- The percentage of students in Guilford County (NC) who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 68 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (69 percent).

### NAEP Achievement-Level Percentages and Average Score Results





### Score Gaps for Student Groups

- In 2019, Black students had an average score that was 29 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (33 points).
- In 2019, Hispanic students had an average score that was 17 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (26 points).
- In 2019, female students in Guilford County (NC) had an average score that was higher than that for male students by 15 points.
- In 2019, students who were eligible for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), had an average score that was 26 points lower than that for students who were not eligible. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (22 points).
