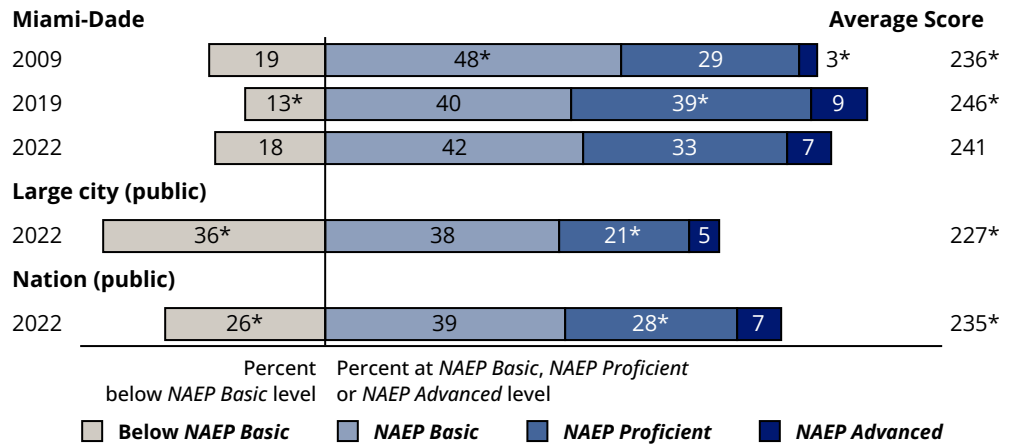


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2022, the average score of fourth-grade students in Miami-Dade was 241. This was higher than the average score of 227 for students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Miami-Dade in 2022 (241) was lower than their average score in 2019 (246) and was higher than their average score in 2009 (236).
- The percentage of students in Miami-Dade who performed at or above the NAEP Proficient level was 40 percent in 2022. This percentage was smaller than that in 2019 (47 percent) and was greater than that in 2009 (33 percent).
- The percentage of students in Miami-Dade who performed at or above the NAEP Basic level was 82 percent in 2022. This percentage was smaller than that in 2019 (87 percent) and was not significantly different from that in 2009 (81 percent).

\* Significantly different ( $p < .05$ ) from the district's results in 2022. Significance tests were performed using unrounded numbers.

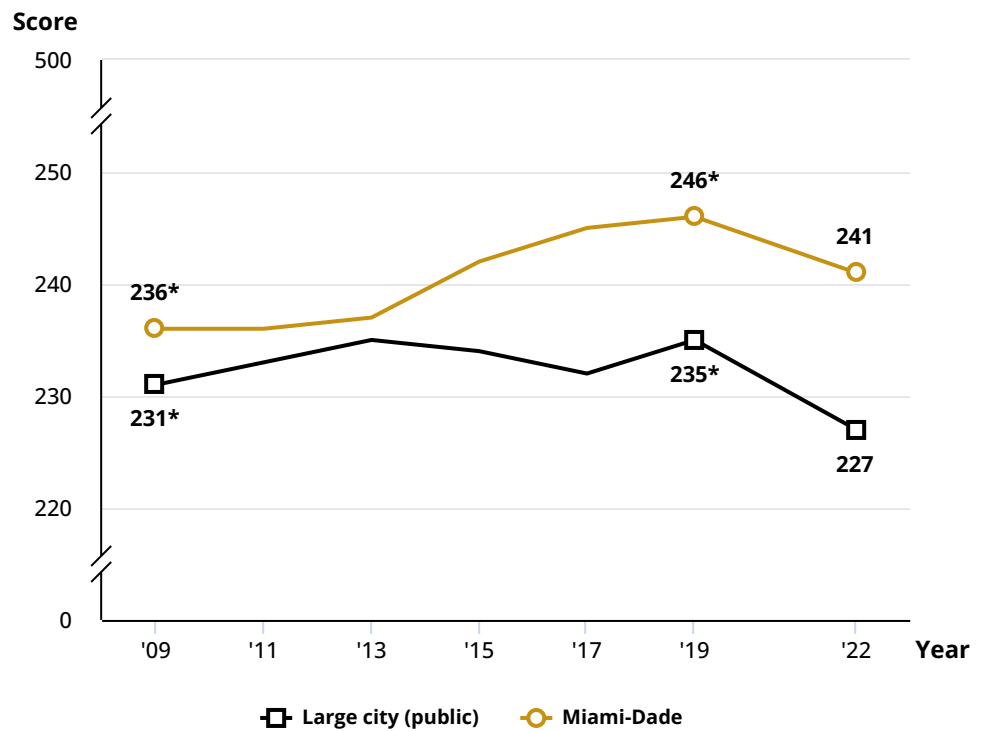

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2022, Black students had an average score that was 32 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (32 points).
- In 2022, Hispanic students had an average score that was 15 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (15 points).
- In 2022, male students in Miami-Dade had an average score that was higher than that for female students by 5 points.
- In 2022, students who were eligible for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) had an average score that was 18 points lower than that for students who were not eligible. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (19 points).
