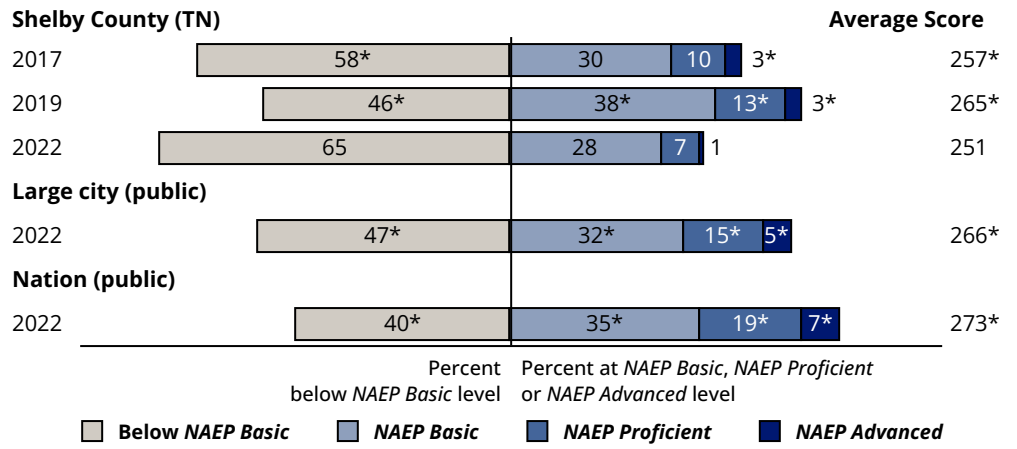


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2022, the average score of eighth-grade students in Shelby County was 251. This was lower than the average score of 266 for students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Shelby County in 2022 (251) was lower than their average score in 2019 (265) and in 2017 (257).
- The percentage of students in Shelby County who performed at or above the NAEP Proficient level was 8 percent in 2022. This percentage was smaller than that in 2019 (16 percent) and in 2017 (12 percent).
- The percentage of students in Shelby County who performed at or above the NAEP Basic level was 35 percent in 2022. This percentage was smaller than that in 2019 (54 percent) and in 2017 (42 percent).

\* Significantly different ( $p < .05$ ) from the district's results in 2022. Significance tests were performed using unrounded numbers.

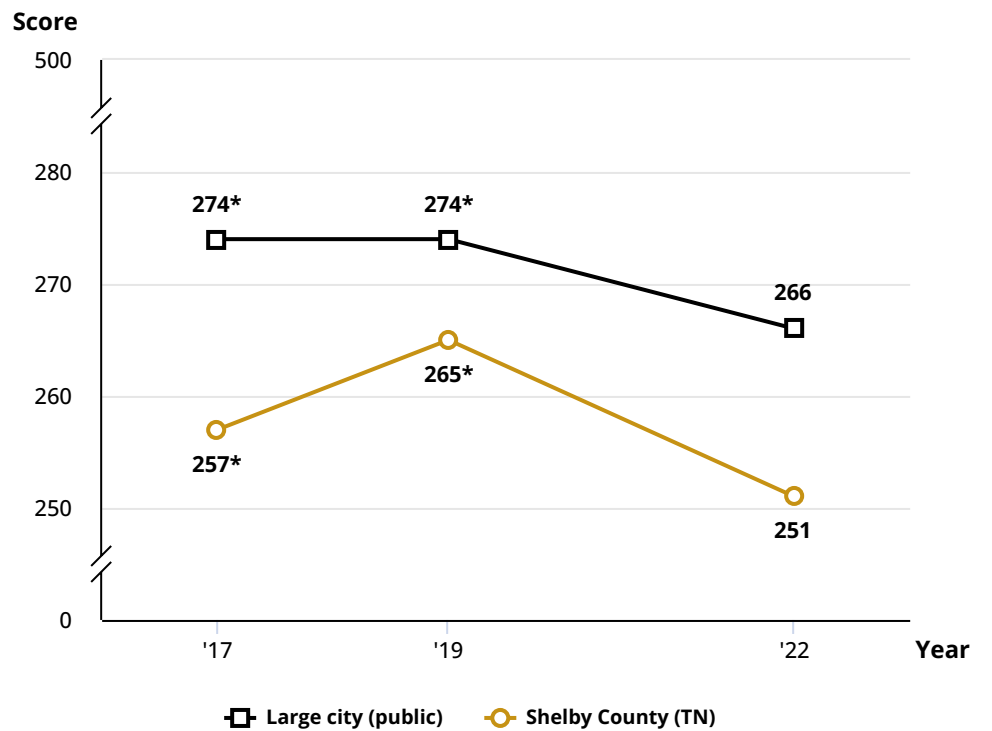

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2022, Hispanic students had an average score that was 7 points higher than that for Black students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (9 points).
- In 2022, male students in Shelby County had an average score that was not significantly different from that for female students.
- In 2022, students who were eligible for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) had an average score that was 13 points lower than that for students who were not eligible. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (19 points).
