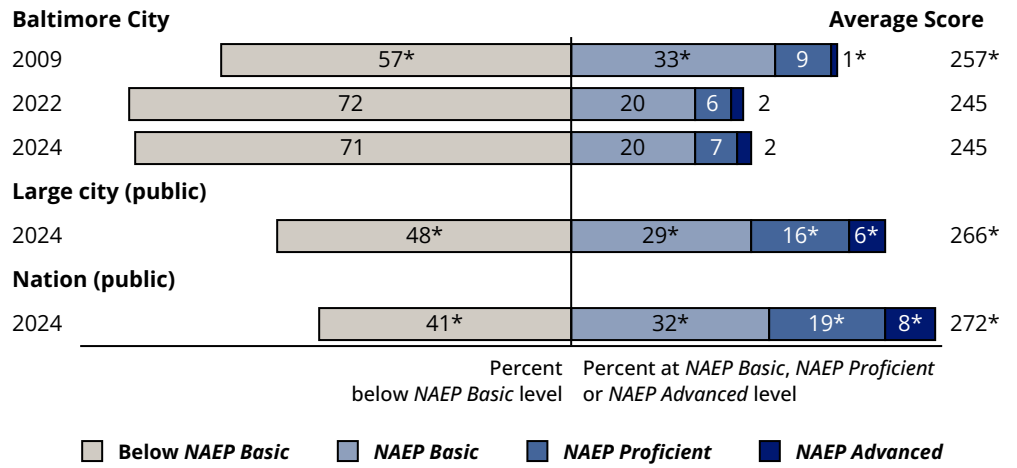


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2024, the average score of eighth-grade students in Baltimore City was 245. This was lower than the average score of 266 for students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Baltimore City in 2024 (245) was not significantly different from their average score in 2022 (245) and was lower than their average score in 2009 (257).
- The percentage of students in Baltimore City who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 9 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (8 percent) and in 2009 (10 percent).
- The percentage of students in Baltimore City who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 29 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (28 percent) and was smaller than that in 2009 (43 percent).

* Significantly different ($p < .05$) from the district's results in 2024. Significance tests were performed using unrounded numbers.

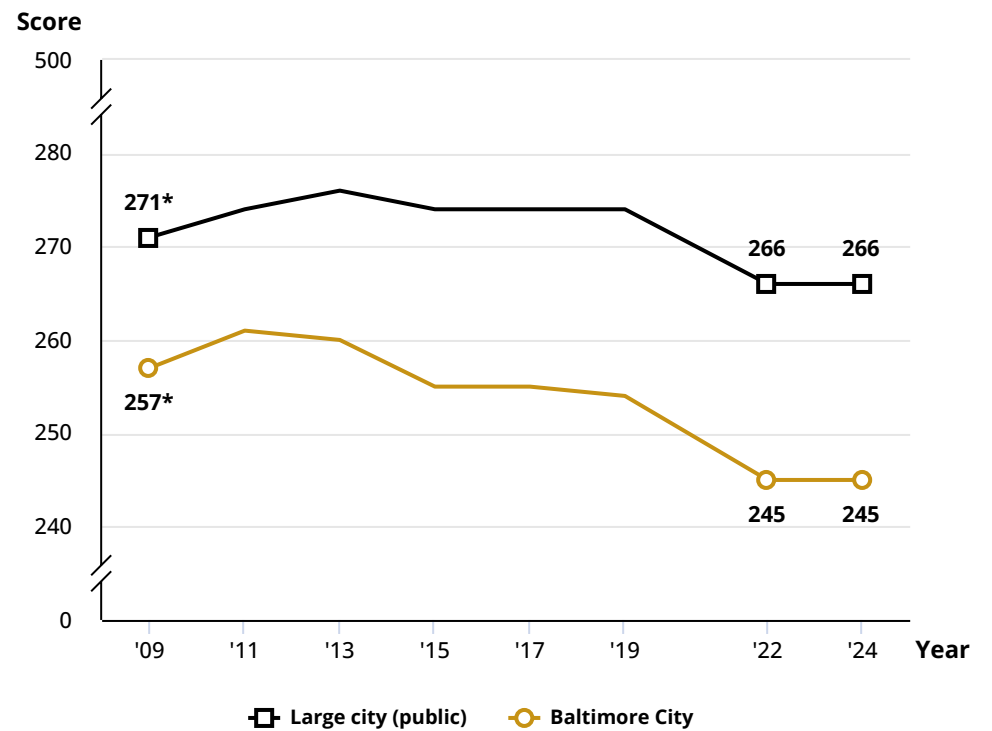

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2024, Black students had an average score that was 39 points lower than that for White students. Data are not reported for White students in 2009, because reporting standards were not met.
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 31 points lower than that for White students. Data are not reported for White and Hispanic students in 2009, because reporting standards were not met.
- In 2024, male students in Baltimore City had an average score that was not significantly different from that for female students.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 26 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (17 points).
