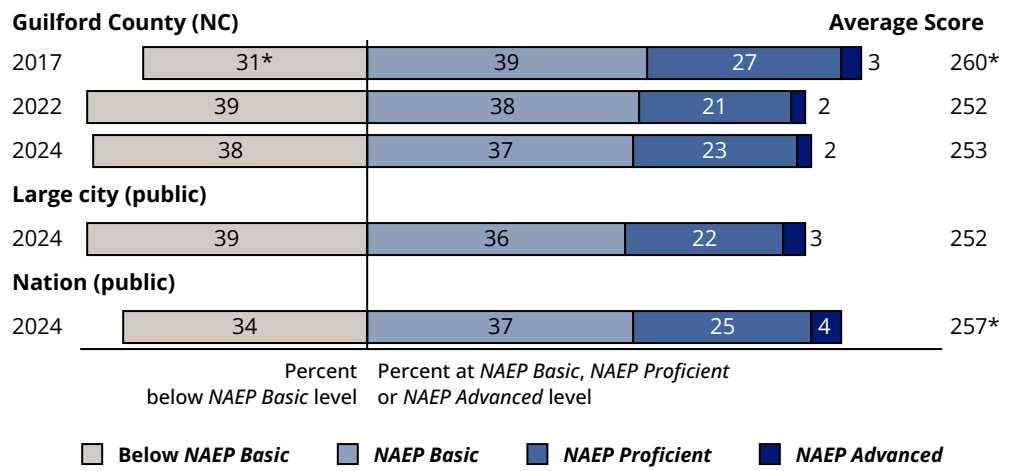


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2024, the average score of eighth-grade students in Guilford County was 253. This was not significantly different from the average score of 252 for students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Guilford County in 2024 (253) was not significantly different from their average score in 2022 (252) and was lower than their average score in 2017 (260).
- The percentage of students in Guilford County who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 25 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (23 percent) and in 2017 (30 percent).
- The percentage of students in Guilford County who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 62 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (61 percent) and was smaller than that in 2017 (69 percent).

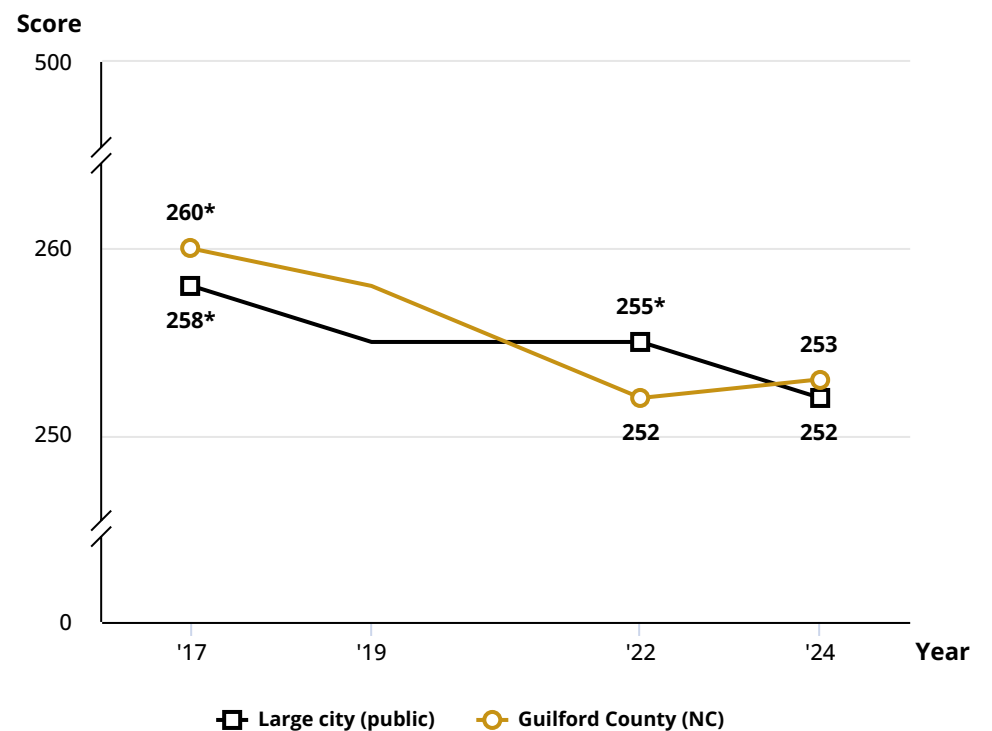

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2024, Black students had an average score that was 33 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (33 points).
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 26 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (26 points).
- In 2024, male students in Guilford County had an average score that was lower than that for female students by 6 points.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 23 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2017 (22 points).
