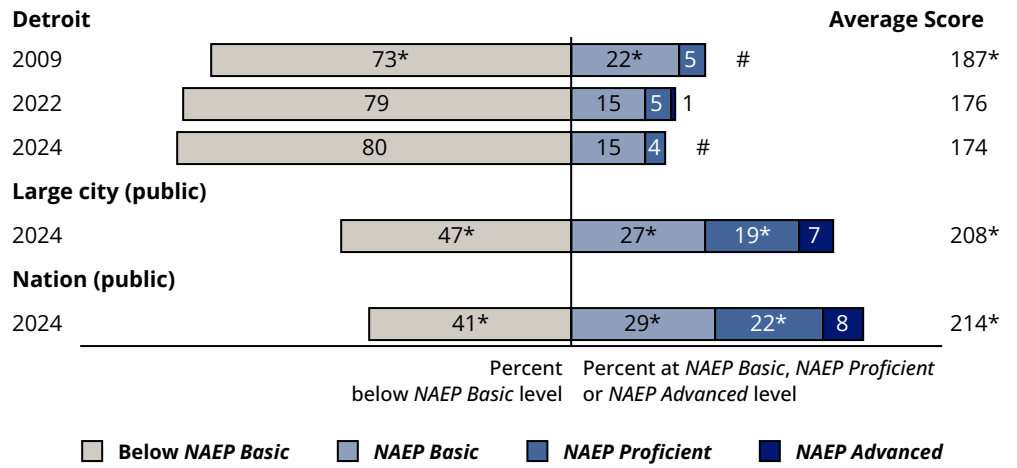


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2024, the average score of fourth-grade students in Detroit was 174. This was lower than the average score of 208 for students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Detroit in 2024 (174) was not significantly different from their average score in 2022 (176) and was lower than their average score in 2009 (187).
- The percentage of students in Detroit who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 5 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (5 percent) and in 2009 (5 percent).
- The percentage of students in Detroit who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 20 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (21 percent) and was smaller than that in 2009 (27 percent).

NAEP ACHIEVEMENT-LEVEL PERCENTAGES AND AVERAGE SCORE RESULTS



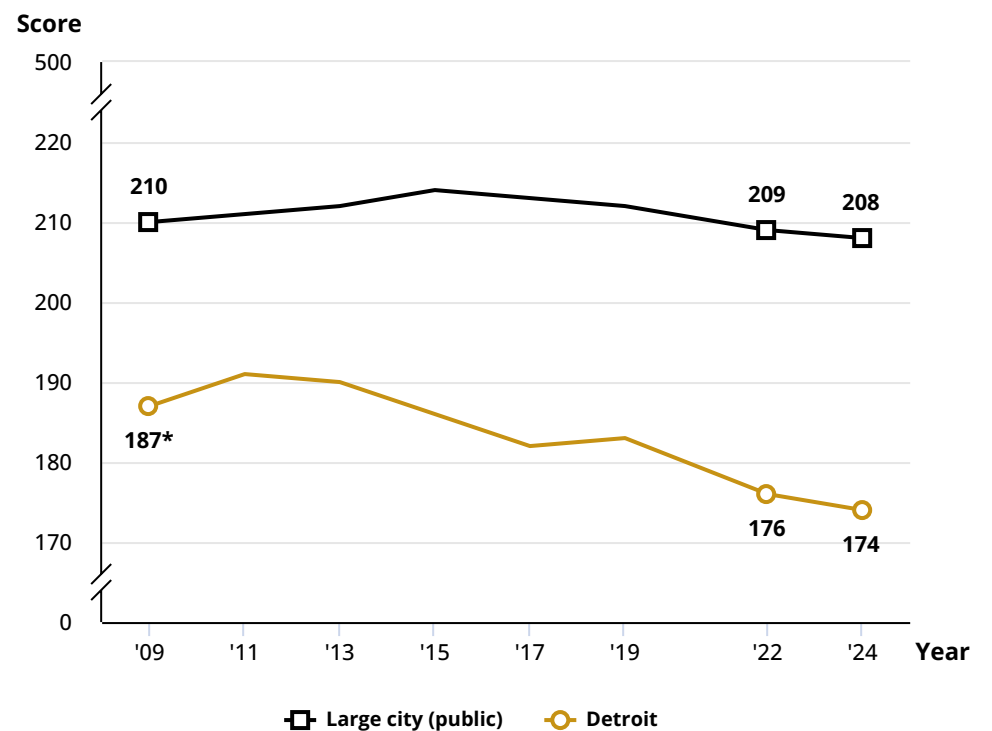

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was not significantly different from that for Black students.
- In 2024, male students in Detroit had an average score that was lower than that for female students by 12 points.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was not significantly different from that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged.
