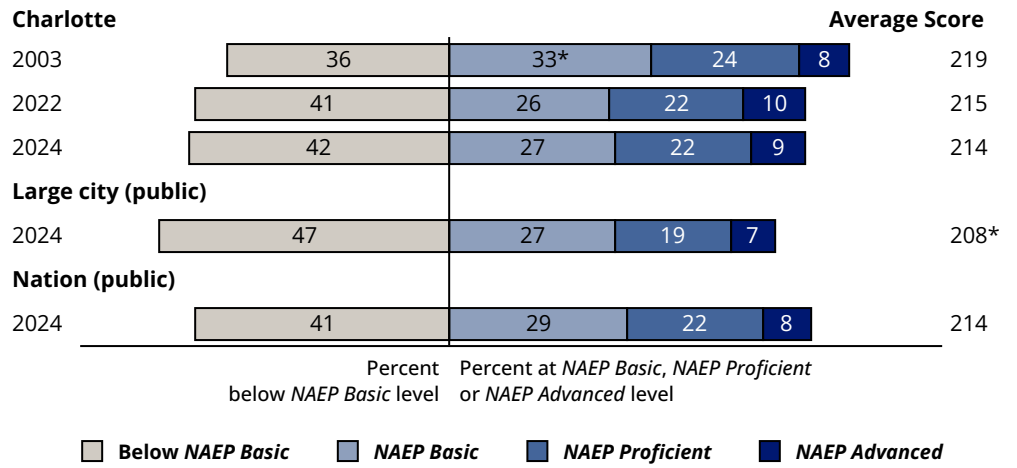


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2024, the average score of fourth-grade students in Charlotte was 214. This was higher than the average score of 208 for students in large cities.
- The average score for students in Charlotte in 2024 (214) was not significantly different from their average score in 2022 (215) and in 2003 (219).
- The percentage of students in Charlotte who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 31 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (33 percent) and in 2003 (31 percent).
- The percentage of students in Charlotte who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 58 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (59 percent) and in 2003 (64 percent).

\* Significantly different ( $p < .05$ ) from the district's results in 2024. Significance tests were performed using unrounded numbers.

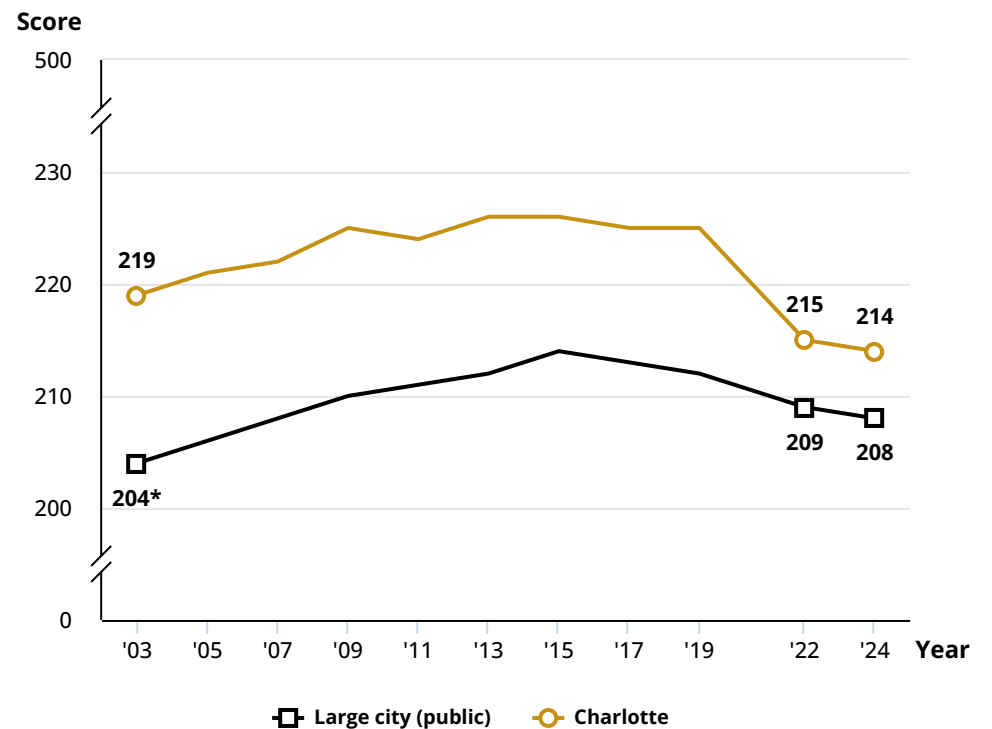

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2024, Black students had an average score that was 39 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2003 (33 points).
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 43 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2003 (35 points).
- In 2024, male students in Charlotte had an average score that was lower than that for female students by 12 points.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 27 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2003 (34 points).
