


Overall Results

- In 2013, the average score of twelfth-grade students in Michigan was 154. This was not significantly different from the average score of 152 for public school students in the nation.
- The percentage of students in Michigan who performed at or above the NAEP *Proficient* level was 25 percent in 2013. This percentage was not significantly different from the nation (25 percent).
- The percentage of students in Michigan who performed at or above the NAEP *Basic* level was 66 percent in 2013. This percentage was not significantly different from the nation (64 percent).


Achievement-Level Percentages and Average Score Results

Compare the Average Score in 2013 to Other States/Jurisdictions



In 2013, the average score in **Michigan** (154) was

- lower than those in 5 states/jurisdictions
- higher than those in 4 states/jurisdictions
- not significantly different from those in 3 states/jurisdictions

Score Gaps for Student Groups

- In 2013, Black students had an average score that was 31 points lower than White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from the nation (29 points).
- In 2013, Hispanic students had an average score that was 24 points lower than White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from the nation (21 points).
- In 2013, male students in Michigan had an average score that was not significantly different from female students.
