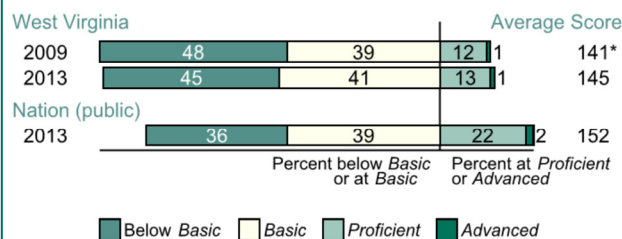


Overall Results

- In 2013, the average score of twelfth-grade students in West Virginia was 145. This was lower than the average score of 152 for public school students in the nation.
- The average score for students in West Virginia in 2013 (145) was higher than their average score in 2009 (141).
- The score gap between higher performing students in West Virginia (those at the 75th percentile) and lower performing students (those at the 25th percentile) was 38 points in 2013. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (41 points).
- The percentage of students in West Virginia who performed at or above the NAEP *Proficient* level was 14 percent in 2013. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2009 (13 percent).
- The percentage of students in West Virginia who performed at or above the NAEP *Basic* level was 55 percent in 2013. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2009 (52 percent).

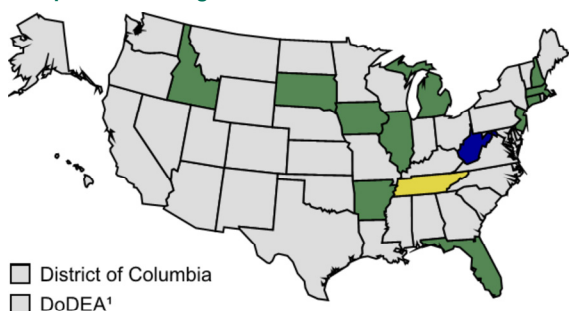
Achievement-Level Percentages and Average Score Results

Compare the Average Score in 2013 to Other States/Jurisdictions

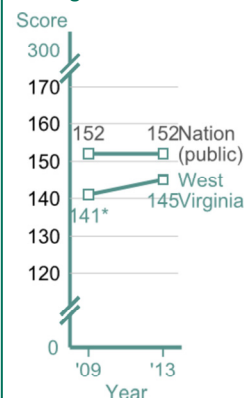

In 2013, the average score in **West Virginia** (145) was

- lower than those in 11 states/jurisdictions
- higher than those in 0 states/jurisdictions
- not significantly different from that in 1 state/jurisdiction

Score Gaps for Student Groups

- In 2013, Black students had an average score that was 12 points lower than White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2009 (21 points).
- Data are not reported for Hispanic students in 2013, because reporting standards were not met.
- In 2013, male students in West Virginia had an average score that was not significantly different from female students.
