


Overall Results


- In 2019, the average score of fourth-grade students in DoDEA was 250. This was higher than the average score of 240 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in DoDEA in 2019 (250) was higher than their average score in 2017 (249) and in 2000 (227).
- The percentage of students in DoDEA who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 54 percent in 2019. This percentage was higher than that in 2017 (51 percent) and in 2000 (21 percent).
- The percentage of students in DoDEA who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 92 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (91 percent) and was higher than that in 2000 (69 percent).

NOTE: NAEP achievement levels are to be used on a trial basis and should be interpreted and used with caution. Detail may not sum to totals because of rounding.


Compare the Average Score in 2019 to Other States/Jurisdictions



In 2019, the average score in DoDEA (250) was
■ lower than those in 0 states/jurisdictions
■ higher than those in 50 states/jurisdictions
■ not significantly different from those in 1 state/jurisdiction

Score Gaps for Student Groups

- In 2019, Black students had an average score that was 12 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was narrower than that in 2000 (20 points).
- In 2019, Hispanic students had an average score that was 8 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was narrower than that in 2000 (14 points).
- In 2019, male students in DoDEA had an average score that was higher than that for female students by 4 points.
- Data are not reported for students who were not eligible and eligible for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) in 2019, because reporting standards were not met.
