


Overall Results


- In 2019, the average score of eighth-grade students in Puerto Rico was 222. This was lower than the average score of 281 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Puerto Rico in 2019 (222) was lower than their average score in 2017 (225) and was higher than their average score in 2011 (218).
- The percentage of students in Puerto Rico who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 1 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (0 percent) and was higher than that in 2011 (0 percent).
- The percentage of students in Puerto Rico who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 9 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (9 percent) and was higher than that in 2011 (5 percent).

Compare the Average Score in 2019 to Other States/Jurisdictions




In 2019, the average score in Puerto Rico (222) was

- lower than those in 52 states/jurisdictions
- higher than those in 0 states/jurisdictions
- not significantly different from those in 0 states/jurisdictions

Average Scores for State/Jurisdiction and Nation




