


## Overall Results


- In 2019, the average score of fourth-grade students in DoDEA was 235. This was higher than the average score of 219 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in DoDEA in 2019 (235) was not significantly different from their average score in 2017 (234) and was higher than their average score in 1998 (220).
- The percentage of students in DoDEA who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 49 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (48 percent) and was higher than that in 1998 (32 percent).
- The percentage of students in DoDEA who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 83 percent in 2019. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2017 (84 percent) and was higher than that in 1998 (66 percent).

NOTE: NAEP achievement levels are to be used on a trial basis and should be interpreted and used with caution. Detail may not sum to totals because of rounding.


## Compare the Average Score in 2019 to Other States/Jurisdictions



In 2019, the average score in DoDEA (235) was  
■ lower than those in 0 states/jurisdictions  
■ higher than those in 51 states/jurisdictions  
■ not significantly different from those in 0 states/jurisdictions

## Score Gaps for Student Groups

- In 2019, Black students had an average score that was 11 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was narrower than that in 1998 (18 points).
- In 2019, Hispanic students had an average score that was 8 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 1998 (15 points).
- In 2019, female students in DoDEA had an average score that was higher than that for male students by 5 points.
- Data are not reported for students who were not eligible and eligible for the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) in 2019, because reporting standards were not met.
