
OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2022, the average score of fourth-grade students in Puerto Rico was 178. This was lower than the average score of 235 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Puerto Rico in 2022 (178) was lower than their average score in 2019 (185) and in 2011 (182).
- The percentage of students in Puerto Rico who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 0 percent in 2022. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2019 (1 percent) and in 2011 (0 percent).
- The percentage of students in Puerto Rico who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 10 percent in 2022. This percentage was smaller than that in 2019 (15 percent) and was not significantly different from that in 2011 (9 percent).


NAEP ACHIEVEMENT-LEVEL PERCENTAGES AND AVERAGE SCORE RESULTS




