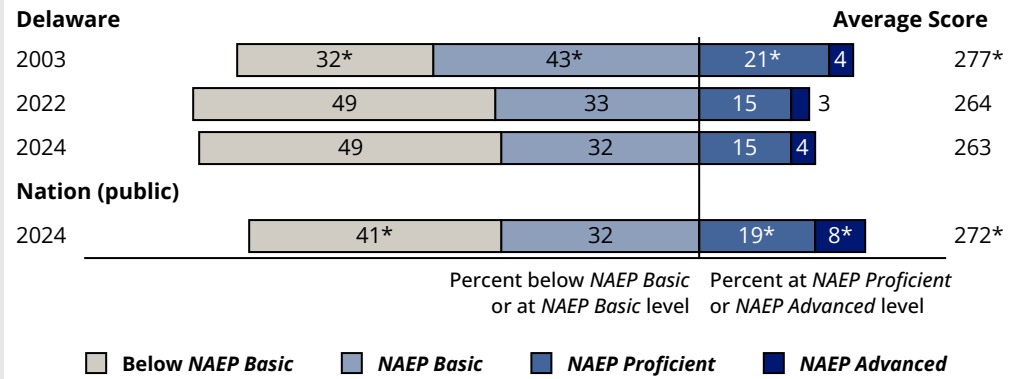


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2024, the average score of eighth-grade students in Delaware was 263. This was lower than the average score of 272 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Delaware in 2024 (263) was not significantly different from their average score in 2022 (264) and was lower than their average score in 2003 (277).
- The percentage of students in Delaware who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 19 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (18 percent) and was smaller than that in 2003 (26 percent).
- The percentage of students in Delaware who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 51 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (51 percent) and was smaller than that in 2003 (68 percent).

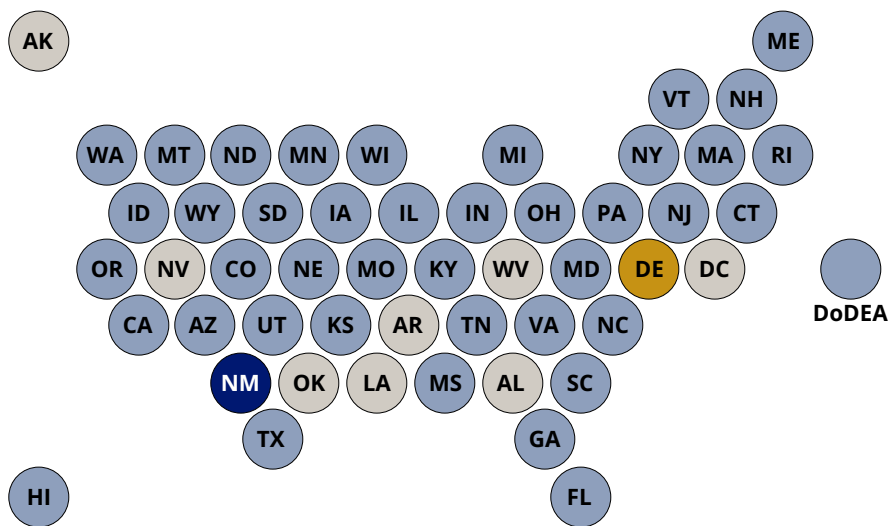
NAEP ACHIEVEMENT-LEVEL PERCENTAGES AND AVERAGE SCORE RESULTS

NOTE: NAEP achievement levels are to be used on a trial basis and should be interpreted and used with caution. Detail may not sum to totals because of rounding.

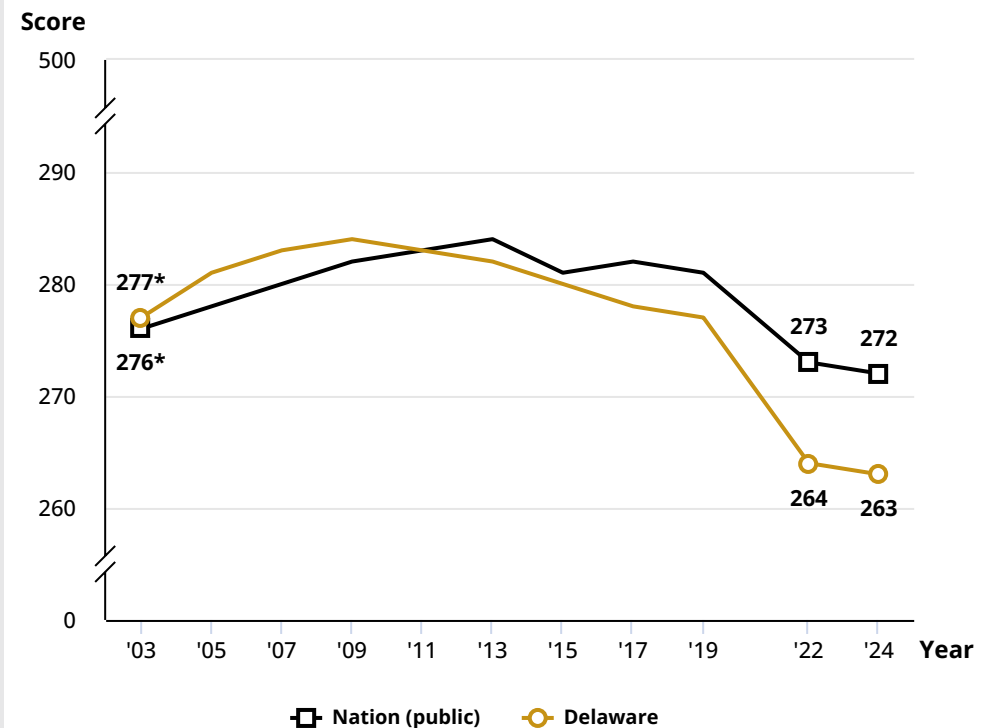
COMPARE THE AVERAGE SCORE IN 2024 TO OTHER STATES/JURISDICTIONS

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2024, Black students had an average score that was 32 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2003 (26 points).
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 20 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was narrower than that in 2003 (30 points).
- In 2024, male students in Delaware had an average score that was not significantly different from that for female students.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 24 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2003 (24 points).
