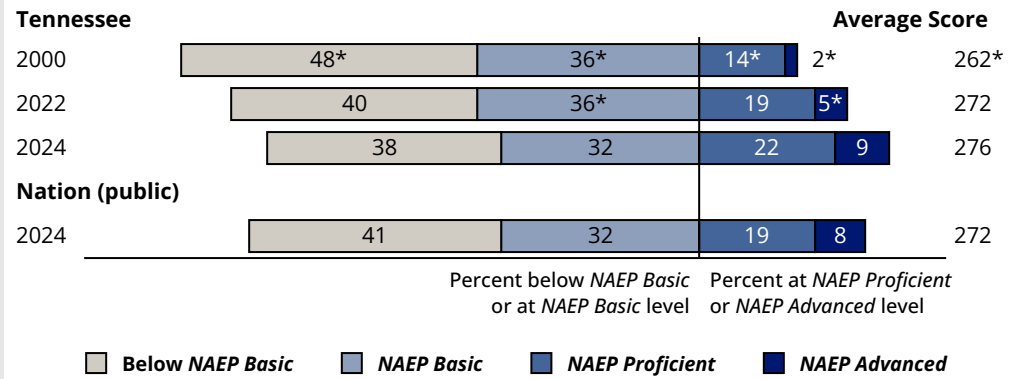


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2024, the average score of eighth-grade students in Tennessee was 276. This was not significantly different from the average score of 272 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Tennessee in 2024 (276) was not significantly different from their average score in 2022 (272) and was higher than their average score in 2000 (262).
- The percentage of students in Tennessee who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 31 percent in 2024. This percentage was greater than that in 2022 (25 percent) and in 2000 (16 percent).
- The percentage of students in Tennessee who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 62 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (60 percent) and was greater than that in 2000 (52 percent).

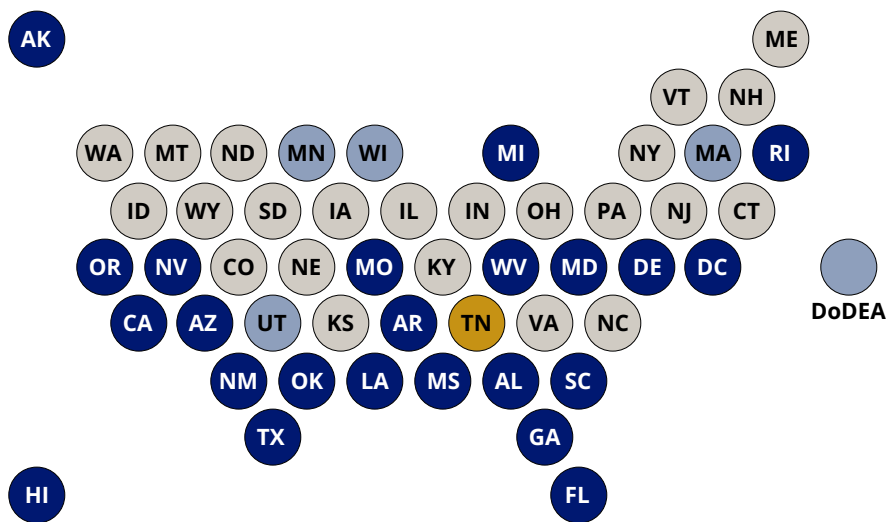
NAEP ACHIEVEMENT-LEVEL PERCENTAGES AND AVERAGE SCORE RESULTS

COMPARE THE AVERAGE SCORE IN 2024 TO OTHER STATES/JURISDICTIONS

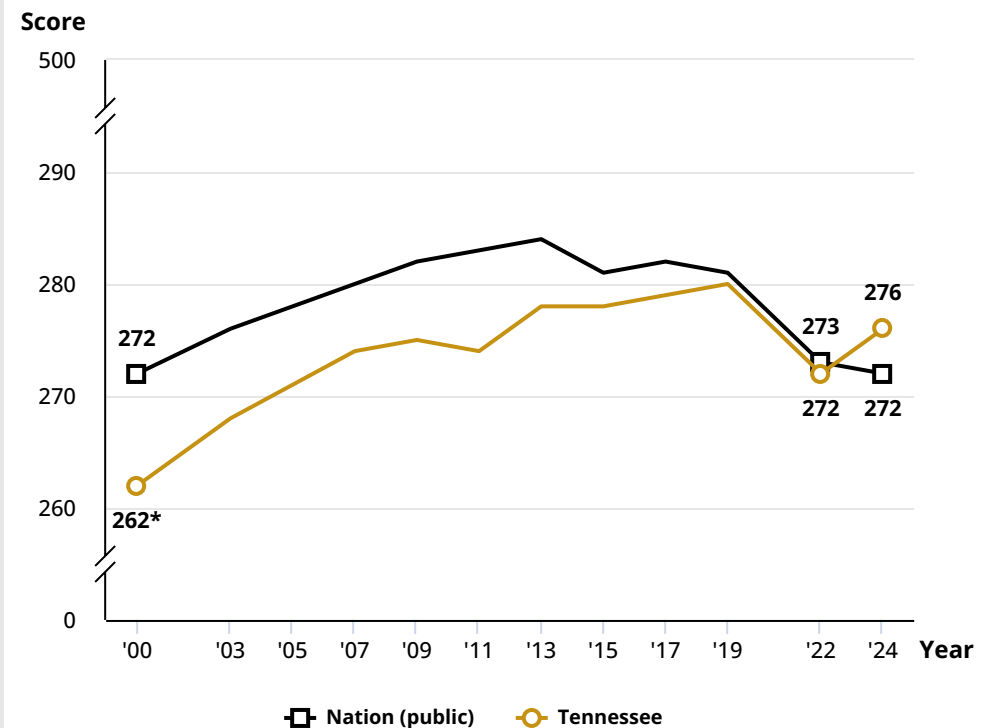


In 2024, the average score in Tennessee (276) was

- lower than those in 5 states/jurisdictions
- higher than those in 23 states/jurisdictions
- not significantly different from those in 23 states/jurisdictions

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2024, Black students had an average score that was 26 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2000 (34 points).
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 30 points lower than that for White students. Data are not reported for Hispanic students in 2000, because reporting standards were not met.
- In 2024, male students in Tennessee had an average score that was not significantly different from that for female students.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 24 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2000 (31 points).
