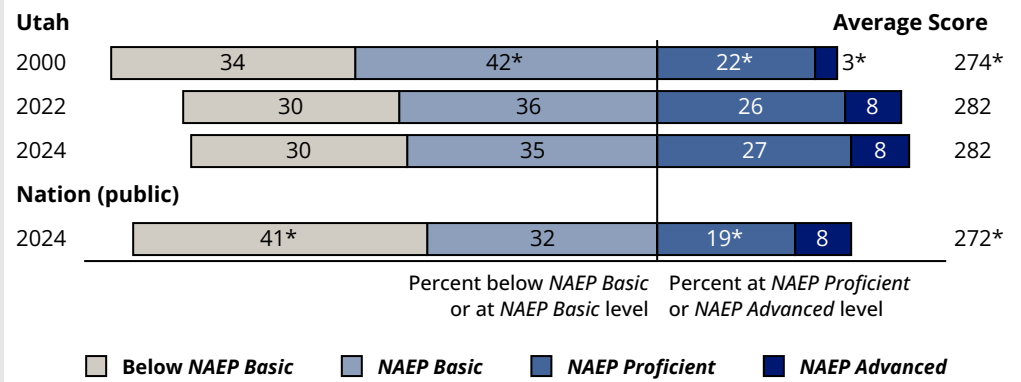


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2024, the average score of eighth-grade students in Utah was 282. This was higher than the average score of 272 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Utah in 2024 (282) was not significantly different from their average score in 2022 (282) and was higher than their average score in 2000 (274).
- The percentage of students in Utah who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 35 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (35 percent) and was greater than that in 2000 (25 percent).
- The percentage of students in Utah who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 70 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (70 percent) and in 2000 (66 percent).

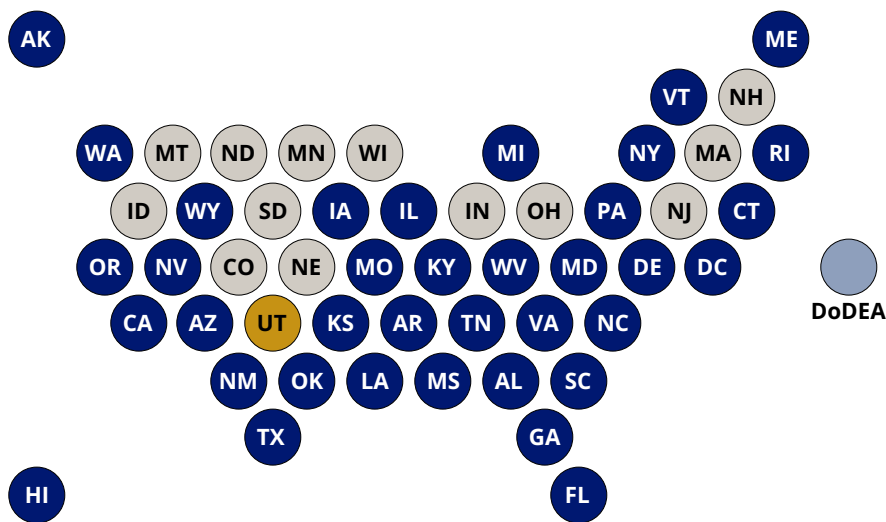
NAEP ACHIEVEMENT-LEVEL PERCENTAGES AND AVERAGE SCORE RESULTS

COMPARE THE AVERAGE SCORE IN 2024 TO OTHER STATES/JURISDICTIONS

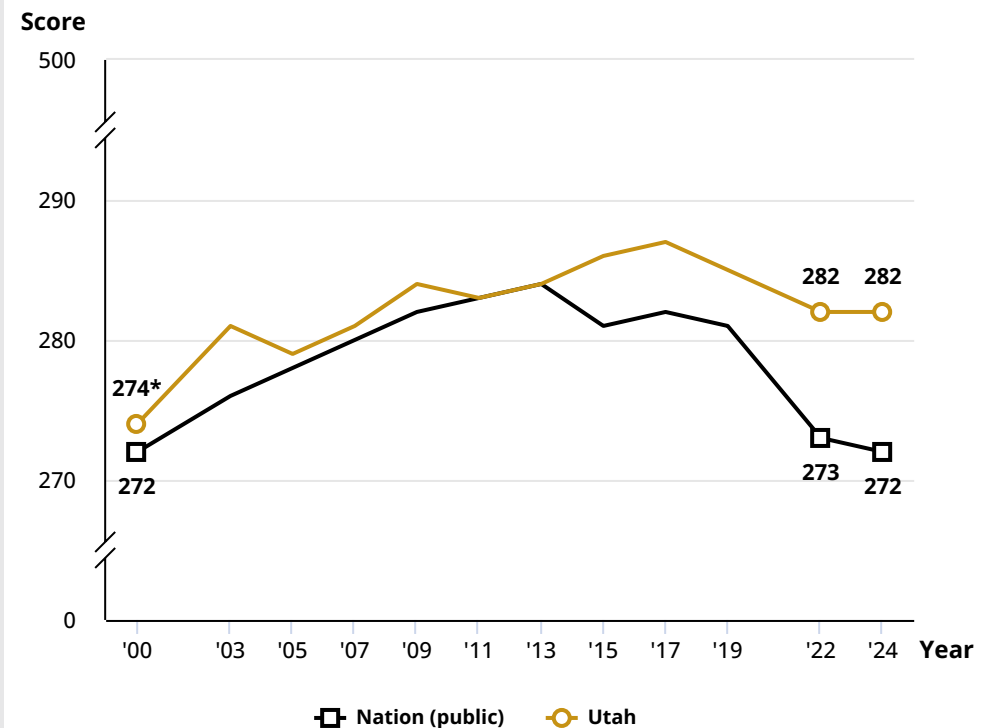


In 2024, the average score in Utah (282) was

- higher than those in 37 states/jurisdictions
- lower than those in 1 states/jurisdictions
- not significantly different from those in 13 states/jurisdictions

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- Data are not reported for Black students in 2024, because reporting standards were not met.
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 29 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2000 (33 points).
- In 2024, male students in Utah had an average score that was not significantly different from that for female students.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 26 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2000 (26 points).
