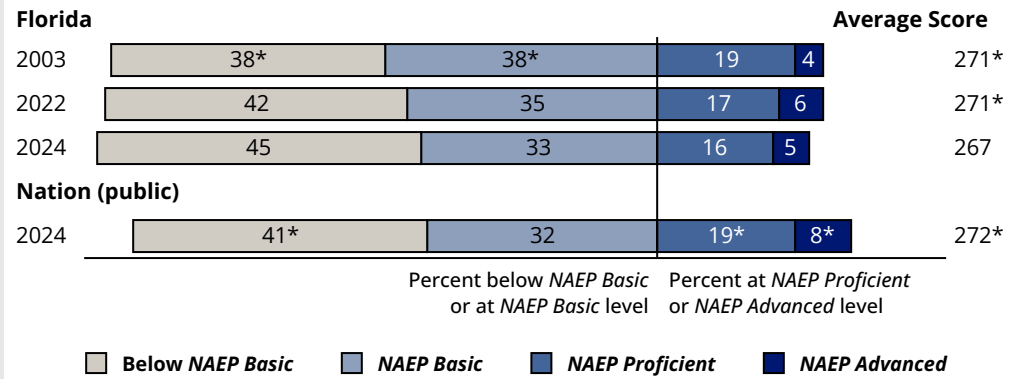


OVERALL RESULTS

- In 2024, the average score of eighth-grade students in Florida was 267. This was lower than the average score of 272 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Florida in 2024 (267) was lower than their average score in 2022 (271) and in 2003 (271).
- The percentage of students in Florida who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 21 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (23 percent) and in 2003 (23 percent).
- The percentage of students in Florida who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 55 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (58 percent) and was smaller than that in 2003 (62 percent).

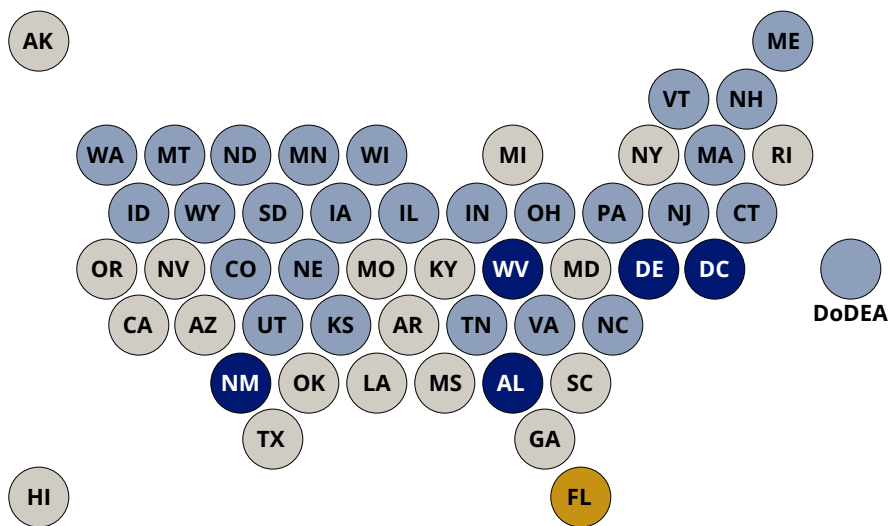
NAEP ACHIEVEMENT-LEVEL PERCENTAGES AND AVERAGE SCORE RESULTS

COMPARE THE AVERAGE SCORE IN 2024 TO OTHER STATES/JURISDICTIONS

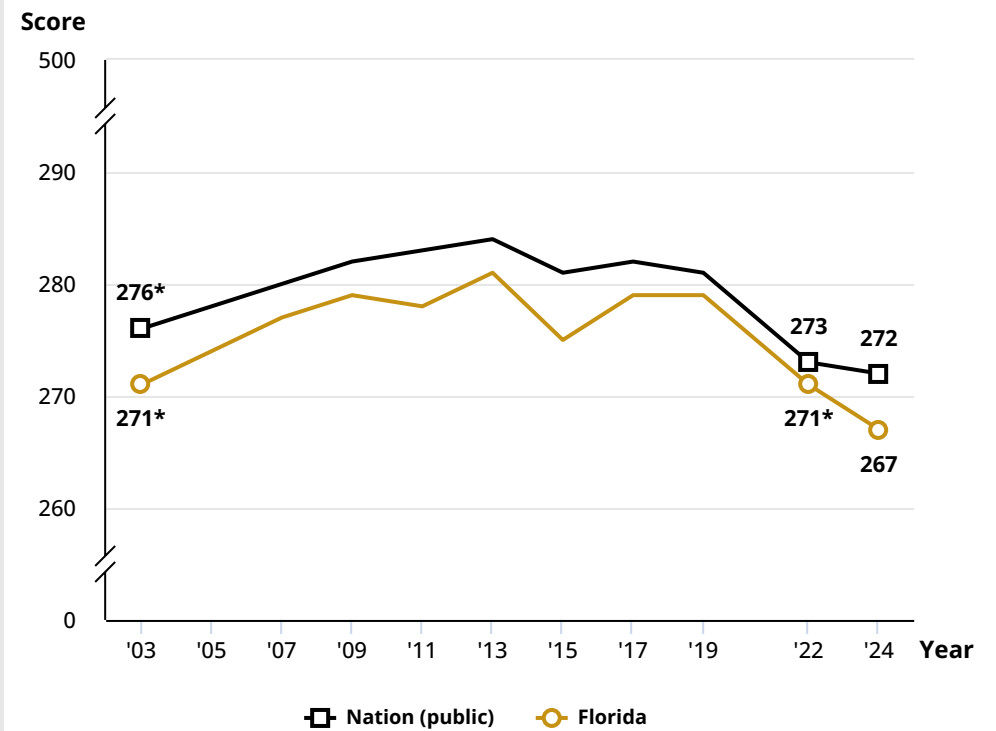


In 2024, the average score in Florida (267) was

- lower than those in 27 states/jurisdictions
- higher than those in 5 states/jurisdictions
- not significantly different from those in 19 states/jurisdictions

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2024, Black students had an average score that was 31 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2003 (37 points).
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 21 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 2003 (22 points).
- In 2024, male students in Florida had an average score that was not significantly different from that for female students.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 19 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was narrower than that in 2003 (28 points).
