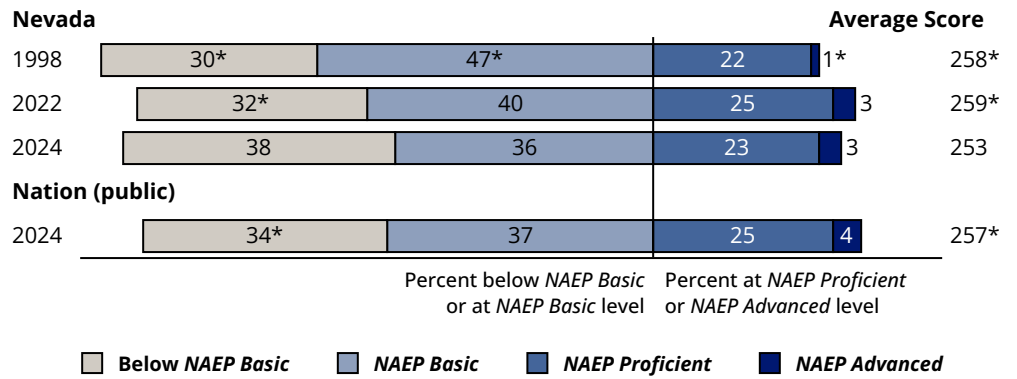


OVERALL RESULTS

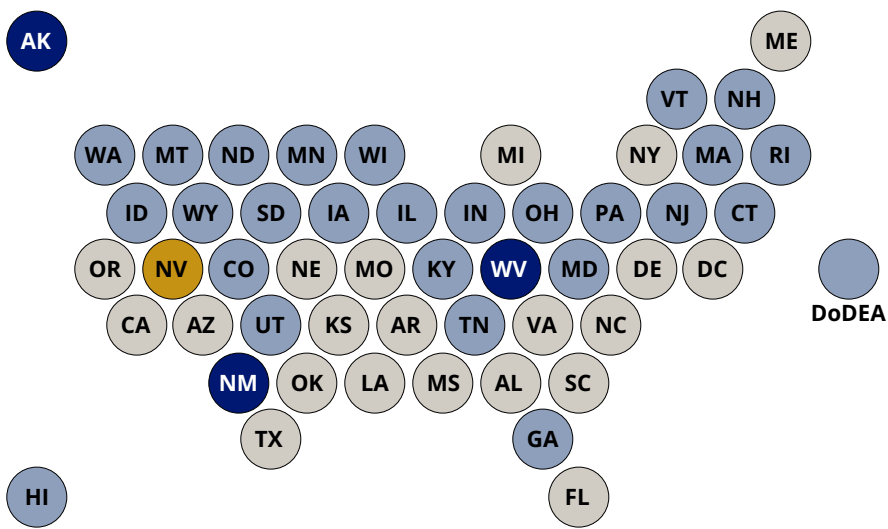
- In 2024, the average score of eighth-grade students in Nevada was 253. This was lower than the average score of 257 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Nevada in 2024 (253) was lower than their average score in 2022 (259) and in 1998 (258).
- The percentage of students in Nevada who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 26 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (29 percent) and in 1998 (23 percent).
- The percentage of students in Nevada who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 62 percent in 2024. This percentage was smaller than that in 2022 (68 percent) and in 1998 (70 percent).

NOTE: NAEP achievement levels are to be used on a trial basis and should be interpreted and used with caution. Detail may not sum to totals because of rounding.

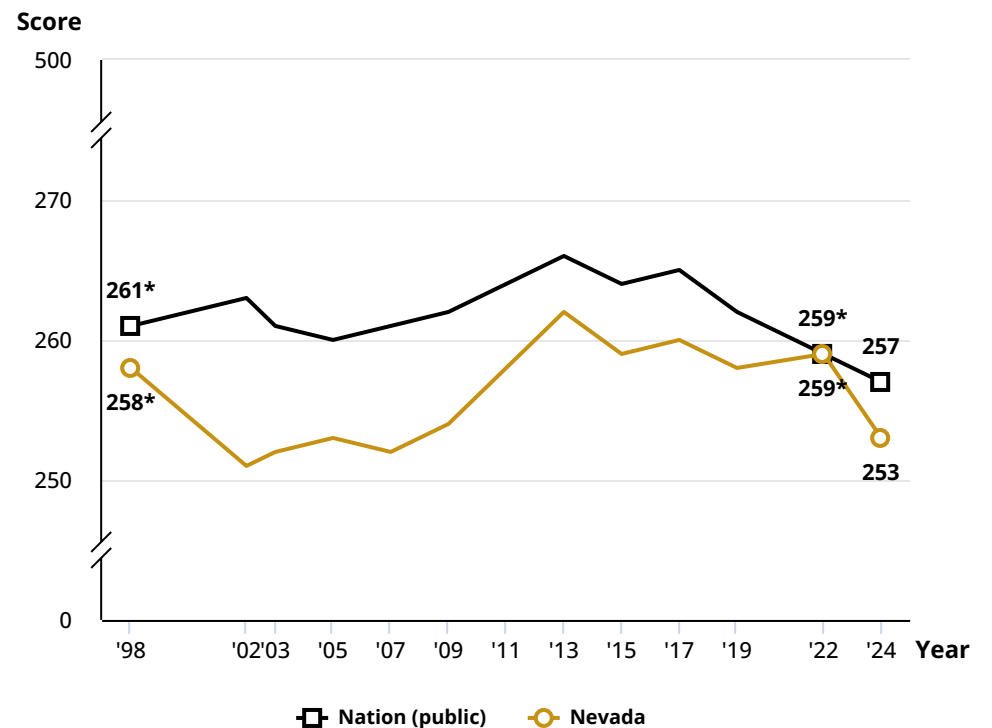
COMPARE THE AVERAGE SCORE IN 2024 TO OTHER STATES/JURISDICTIONS

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2024, Black students had an average score that was 19 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 1998 (23 points).
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 16 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 1998 (22 points).
- In 2024, male students in Nevada had an average score that was lower than that for female students by 12 points.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 19 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 1998 (19 points).
