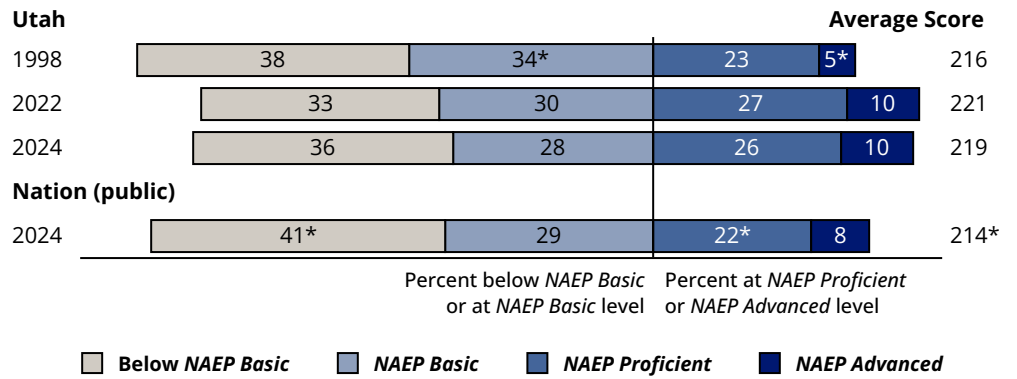


OVERALL RESULTS

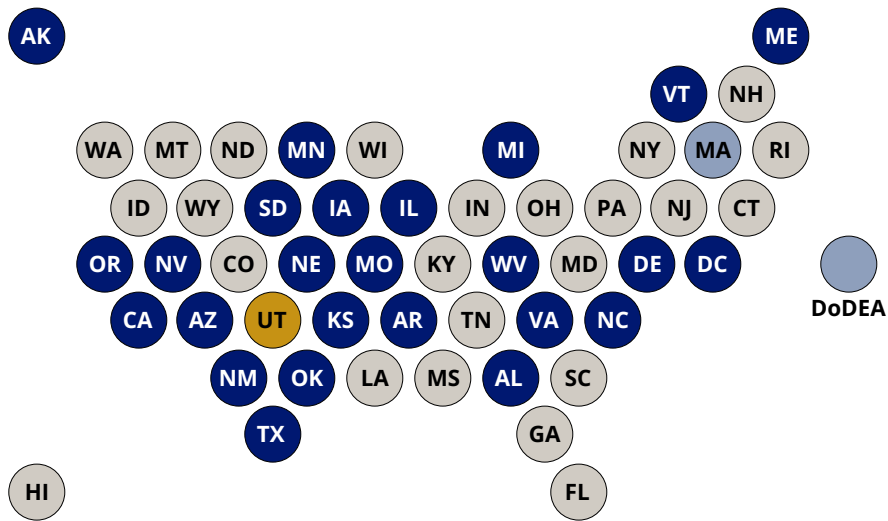
- In 2024, the average score of fourth-grade students in Utah was 219. This was higher than the average score of 214 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Utah in 2024 (219) was not significantly different from their average score in 2022 (221) and in 1998 (216).
- The percentage of students in Utah who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 36 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (37 percent) and was greater than that in 1998 (28 percent).
- The percentage of students in Utah who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 64 percent in 2024. This percentage was not significantly different from that in 2022 (67 percent) and in 1998 (62 percent).

NAEP ACHIEVEMENT-LEVEL PERCENTAGES AND AVERAGE SCORE RESULTS



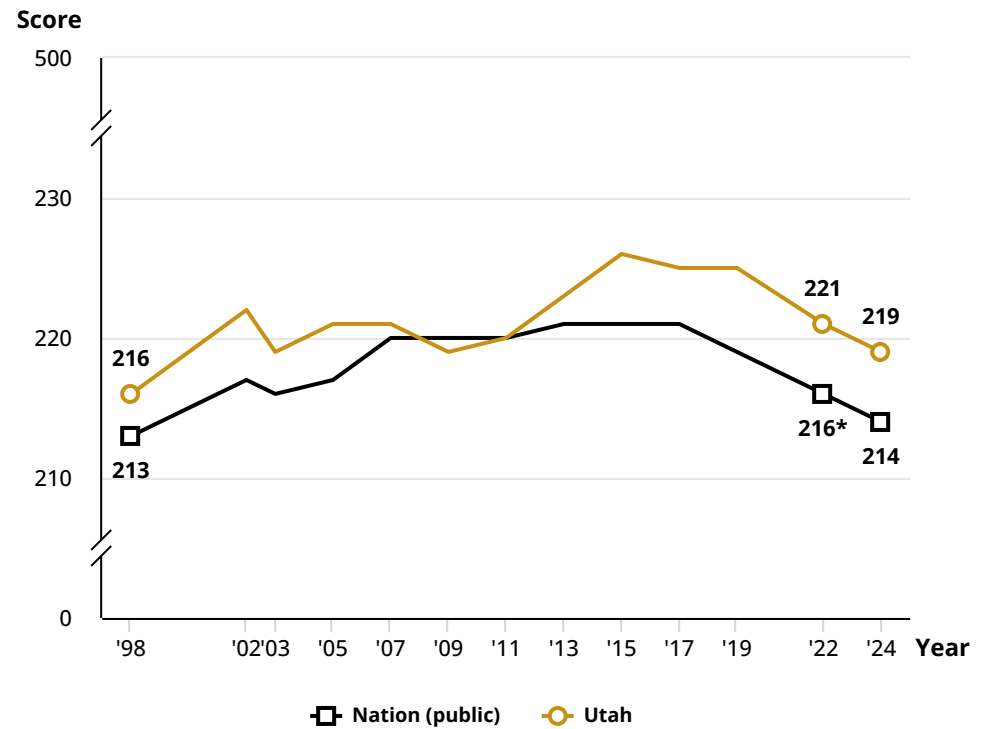

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- Data are not reported for Black students in 2024, because reporting standards were not met.
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 30 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 1998 (29 points).
- In 2024, male students in Utah had an average score that was lower than that for female students by 7 points.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 29 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was wider than that in 1998 (17 points).
