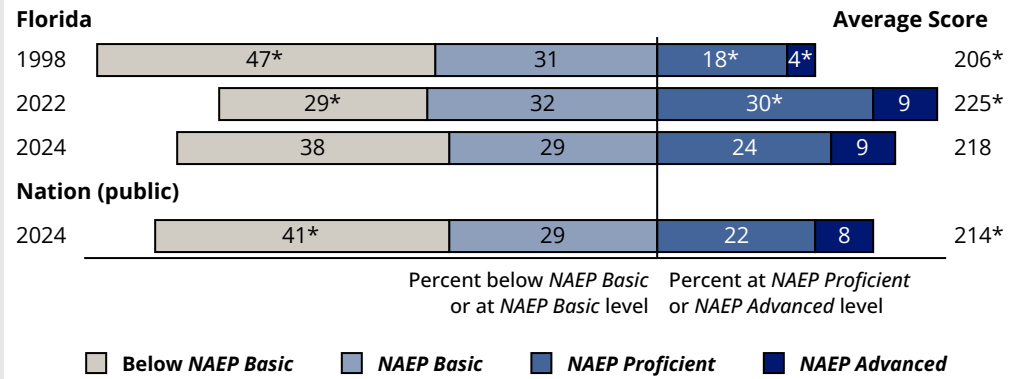


OVERALL RESULTS

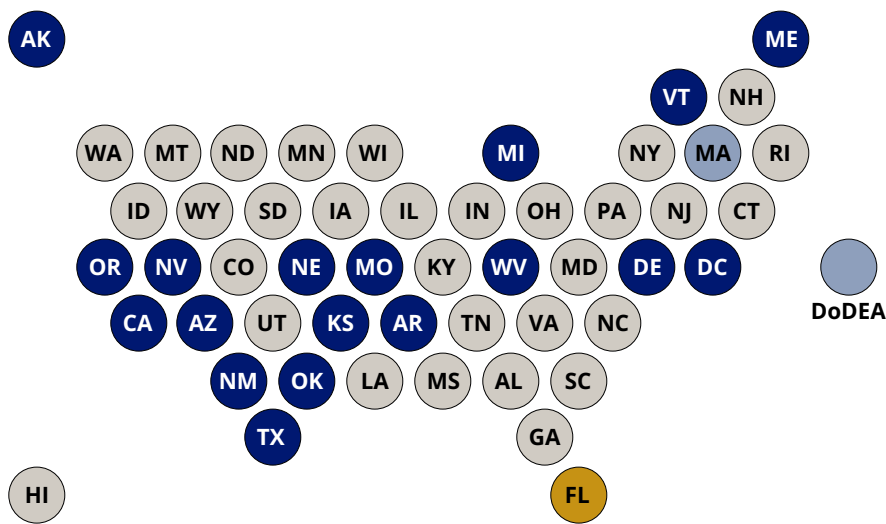
- In 2024, the average score of fourth-grade students in Florida was 218. This was higher than the average score of 214 for students in the nation.
- The average score for students in Florida in 2024 (218) was lower than their average score in 2022 (225) and was higher than their average score in 1998 (206).
- The percentage of students in Florida who performed at or above the *NAEP Proficient* level was 33 percent in 2024. This percentage was smaller than that in 2022 (39 percent) and was greater than that in 1998 (22 percent).
- The percentage of students in Florida who performed at or above the *NAEP Basic* level was 62 percent in 2024. This percentage was smaller than that in 2022 (71 percent) and was greater than that in 1998 (53 percent).

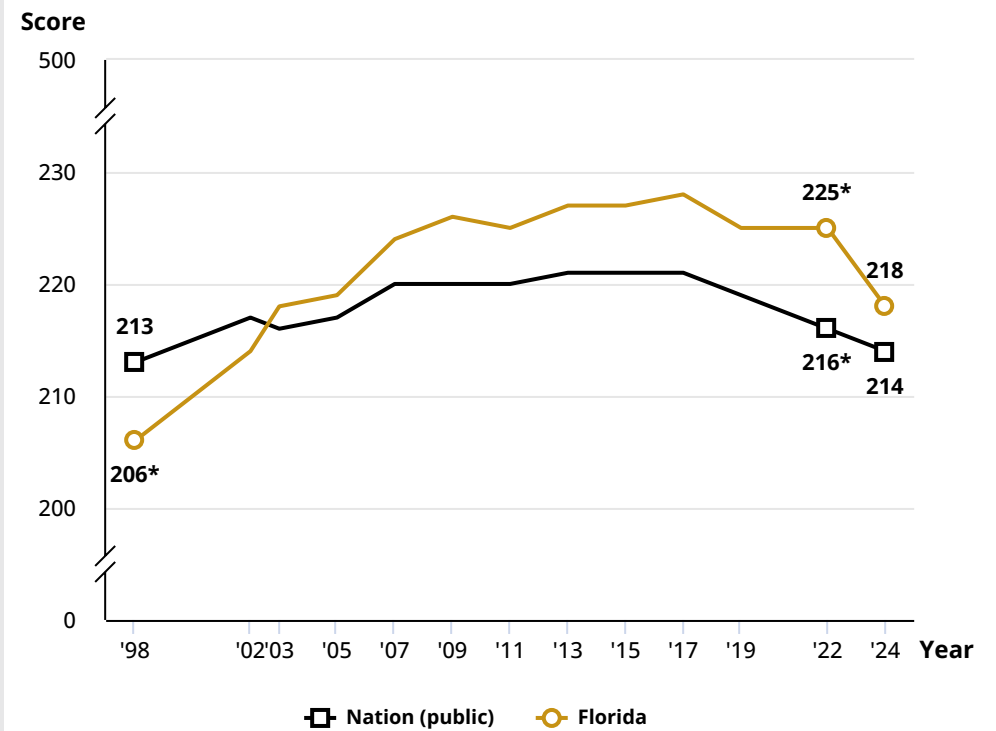
COMPARE THE AVERAGE SCORE IN 2024 TO OTHER STATES/JURISDICTIONS

SCORE GAPS FOR STUDENT GROUPS

- In 2024, Black students had an average score that was 23 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was narrower than that in 1998 (31 points).
- In 2024, Hispanic students had an average score that was 13 points lower than that for White students. This performance gap was not significantly different from that in 1998 (20 points).
- In 2024, male students in Florida had an average score that was lower than that for female students by 9 points.
- In 2024, students who were identified as economically disadvantaged had an average score that was 20 points lower than that for students who were identified as not economically disadvantaged. This performance gap was narrower than that in 1998 (29 points).
