0028	Adequate Yearly Progress Status	An indication of whether the state, district, or school met the Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) requirements for the school year, as determined by the state-established criteria.	An indication as to whether the education institution meets Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) standards.
0208	Position Title	The descriptive name of a person's position.	The descriptive name of an individual's position.
0239	Related Learning Standards	An indication of the state or local standard(s) addressed in the Class Section.	An indication of the state or local standard(s) addressed in the lesson.
0282	Estimated Time Element	The actual or estimated number of clock minutes required for class completion. This number is especially important for career and technical education classes and may represent (in minutes) the clock hour requirement of the class, the number of minutes (or clock hours) of class time per week, and/or the number of equivalent weeks the class typically meets.	The actual or estimated number of clock hours or minutes required for class completion. This number is especially important for occupational or vocational classes and may represent the clock hour requirement of the class, the number of minutes (or clock hours) of class time per week, and/or the number of equivalent weeks the class typically meets.
0310	Hispanic or Latino Ethnicity	An indication that the person traces his or her origin or descent to Mexico, Puerto Rico, Cuba, Central and South America, and other Spanish cultures, regardless of race.	An indication that the individual traces his or her origin or descent to Mexico, Puerto Rico, Cuba, Central and South America, and other Spanish cultures, regardless of race. The term, "Spanish origin," can be used in addition to "Hispanic or Latino."
0314	Birthdate	The year, month and day on which a person was born.	The month, day, and year on which an individual was born.
0354	Immunization Date	The year, month and day of an immunization.	The month, day, and year on which an individual receives an immunization.
0423	Fee Payment Status	An indication of whether a required fee was paid.	An indication of the amount of money received from an individual as payment toward fees required for receipt of a credential.
0458	Application Date	The year, month and day on which an individual application is received by the organization.	The month, day, and year on which the individual filed the employment application.
0467	Hire Date	The year, month and day on which a person was hired for a position, or consecutive positions within the same organization and job classification.	The month, day, and year on which an individual was hired for a position.
