

Recommendations of the Crime, Violence, and Discipline Reporting Task Force

Recommendations of the Crime, Violence, and Discipline Reporting Task Force is presented as a voluntary model for improving state and local education agency procedures for collecting data on crime, violence, and discipline in schools. The report recommends a data system structure, a list of data items that can be collected, key concepts and assumptions about incident reporting, and definitions for school safety data elements. It is hoped that use of such a model will result in more comparable and uniform education data collection across the Nation.
