Highlights From PISA 2009: Performance of U.S. 15-Year-Old Students in Reading, Mathematics, and Science Literacy in an International Context (NCES 2011-004) and supplemental tables

Since the report and supplemental tables were released on December 7, 2010, the following changes have been made and are now reflected in the PDFs available for viewing and downloading.

Report: Text has been added and revised on pages 16, 21, and 27, where trends in reading, mathematics, and science are discussed. Minor formatting and wording changes have been made for internal consistency and correctness (e.g., font changes) and to ensure consistency between the report and supplemental tables. In table 4, an exclamation point was added to the score difference for Colombia. There have been no changes in the data reported.

Supplemental tables: In table R5, Austria's 2000 average reading score and associated standard error have been corrected to reflect the correct weights. Notes in figures R2, M2 and S2 and tables R5, M2 and S2 have been revised.
