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## State Postsecondary Enrollment Distributions by Race/Ethnicity Before and After Changes to Reporting Categories: Fall 2004, 2007, and 2010

These Web Tables provide an initial look at differences in the national and state-level demography of students in postsecondary institutions before and after federally mandated changes in race and ethnicity data collection and reporting. Both national and state-level data include statistics for all students, as well as for the subgroup of students identified as first-time degree or certificate-seeking undergraduates. Three years of fall enrollment data are detailed: (1) fall 2004, prior to any changes in reporting categories; (2) fall 2007, the last year in which the prior reporting categories were used by all institutions, and (3) fall 2010, the first year in which all institutions employed the new reporting categories.

The race and ethnicity reporting changes described were required as a result of new standards issued by the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) in 1997 and the final guidance

issued by the U.S. Department of Education in 2007. Known as *Statistical Policy Directive Number 15: Race and Ethnic Standards for Federal Statistics and Administrative Reporting*, the OMB directive requires institutions to use a two-question format to collect data on a student's Hispanic/Latino ethnicity separately from his or her identification with one or more race categories. Individuals cannot be required to provide their race and ethnicity information. The guidance developed by the U.S. Department of Education in 2007 requires that the aggregate data reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS) use the following nine categories first required with the reporting of fall 2010 enrollment data: (1) nonresident alien of any race or ethnicity, (2) race and ethnicity unknown, (3) Hispanic or Latino of any race, (4) American Indian or Alaska Native, (5) Asian, (6) Black or African American, (7) Native

Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander, (8) White, and (9) Two or more races. This represents an expansion of the categories used in 2007 and before, which made no explicit distinction between race and ethnicity and included the following seven reporting categories: (1) nonresident alien, (2) unknown race/ethnicity, (3) American Indian/Alaskan Native, (4) Asian/Pacific Islander, (5) Black, non-Hispanic, (6) Hispanic, and (7) White, non-Hispanic.

Readers are reminded that any observed differences in distribution when comparing 2007 to 2010 may not be due solely to changes in the race and ethnicity reporting requirements, but also to underlying changes in demography. To help provide additional context for any changes observed when comparing 2007 to 2010, analogous data are provided for comparison of 2004 to 2007. Additionally, because institutions were not required

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to resurvey currently enrolled students to revise existing institutional records, the percentage of individuals whose race and ethnicity are unknown may be high and the percentages of those identified as Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander or classified into Two or more races may be low. Only 2010 data pertaining to first-time degree- or certificate- seeking undergraduates were collected exclusively in the new two-question format. ## DATA

Data in these Web Tables were collected primarily through part A of the IPEDS Enrollment component. The Enrollment component collects the number of students enrolled during the fall of each year, by level of student, full- or part-time enrollment status of student, race/ethnicity of student, and gender of student.

IPEDS is the core postsecondary education data collection program for NCES. Institution-level data are collected from postsecondary institutions in the United States (50 states and the District of Columbia) and other U.S. jurisdictions. For IPEDS, a postsecondary institution is defined as an organization open to the public that has the provision of postsecondary education as one of its primary missions. IPEDS defines postsecondary education as formal instructional programs with a curriculum designed primarily for students who are beyond the compulsory age for high school. This includes institutions that offer academic, vocational and continuing professional education programs and excludes institutions that offer only avocational (leisure) and adult basic education programs. Data collected via IPEDS cover a variety of areas, including institutional prices, enrollments, graduation rates, program completions, student financial aid, institutional finance, and human resources.

### RACE AND ETHNICITY CATEGORIES

The new standards are based on Revisions to the Standards for the Classification of Federal Data on Race and Ethnicity issued by Office of Management and Budget in 1997. The historical standards were based on the 1977 Statistical Policy Directive Number 15, Race and Ethnic Standards for Federal Statistics and Administrative Reporting.

## TECHNICAL NOTES

The Final Guidance on Maintaining, Collecting, and Reporting Racial and Ethnic Data to the U.S. Department of Education revised the implementation timeline for reporting race and ethnicity data using the new standards. Institutions had the option to use the new race and ethnicity categories during 2008–09 and 2009–10. Institutions were required to report Fall Enrollment and Human Resources survey component data using the new guidelines by 2010–11. For IPEDS 2011–12 and beyond, institutions must use the new race and ethnicity categories for all IPEDS components.

For the fall 2004 and fall 2007 enrollment data collection, the graduate student category did not include first-professional students. These students were collected under a separate level of student category. As a result, table values for fall 2004 and fall 2007 graduate student enrollment were calculated by summing the graduate student category and the first-professional student category. The fall 2010 enrollment data collection did not utilize a separate first-professional category; therefore, institutions reported students enrolled in professional programs in the graduate student category for fall 2010.

The analysis included Title IV postsecondary institutions in the United

States that reported fall enrollment data for fall 2004, fall 2007, or fall 2010.

Title IV institutions are those eligible to participate in the Title IV federal financial aid programs (e.g., Pell Grants and Stafford Loans).

## IPEDS DATA CENTER
