

Errata notice

High School Longitudinal Study of 2009 (HSLs:09) 2013 Update and High School Transcript Study: A First Look at Fall 2009 Ninth-Graders in 2013 (NCES 2015037rev)

Since the report was released in 2015, the following changes have been made and are now reflected in the PDFs available for viewing and downloading.

Report: The updated version of the First Look report corrects several bullets: the first bullet under “Selected Findings,” which refers to table 1; and the last bullet under “Selected Findings,” which refers to table 13.

Bullet 1 was changed to say:

- Approximately ~~89~~ 90 percent of fall 2009 ninth-graders had earned a high school diploma by 2013. Another 3 percent had earned a General Educational Development (GED) credential or other high school equivalency (figure 1 and table 1).

The last bullet was changed to say:

- Fourteen percent of fall 2009 ninth-graders were working full time in 2013, and another 35 ~~14~~ percent were working part time. Those who were working averaged 27 hours of work per week, and earned about \$9.10 per hour (\$1.85 higher than the minimum wage of \$7.25 per hour in 2013) (table 13).

Tables and Figures: Tables 1 and 13 have been corrected, as well as figure 1, which is based on table 1. Estimates that are unstable have been marked with “!” symbols in tables 1, 3, 4, and 6-13.
