In the original release of the report, errors were found with poverty measure estimates in table 9-3. These errors are outlined below.

Table 9-3 estimates by poverty status inadvertently categorized a small number of children (approx. 647,000 out of 51,387,000) incorrectly as poor instead of nonpoor. This error did not affect any of the findings reported in the text, or any other estimates in the table. Values in the table that will change as a result of this correction are shown in red below.
