


Mathematics scores of 8th-grade students on Trends in International Mathematics and Science Study (TIMSS) at selected percentiles, by education system: 2011



NOTE: The mathematics scale ranges from 0 to 1,000. Some apparent differences between estimates may not be statistically significant. Education systems are ordered by the 50th percentile score. U.S. percentiles are marked by horizontal black lines and the United States is highlighted by a vertical grey bar. As an example, the graph indicates that a student scoring at the 75th percentile in the United States would be at about the 25th percentile in Singapore.
