


Average years of experience of lower secondary education teachers and principals in their respective roles, by education system: 2013



¹ The item response rate for the variable on teacher years of experience is below 85 percent. Missing data have not been explicitly accounted for.

² The item response rate for the variable on principal years of experience is below 85 percent. Missing data have not been explicitly accounted for.

NOTE: Values for the variable on teacher years of experience range from 0 to 58, and values for the variable on principal years of experience range from 0 to 50. Some apparent differences between estimates may not be statistically significant. Education systems are ordered by teacher years of experience, from low to high. This graph displays the average years of experience of lower secondary education teachers (grades 7-9 in the United States) and their principals in their respective roles within each education systems. For example, the graph indicates that in the United States, the average lower secondary education teacher has approximately 14 years of experience, and the average lower secondary education principal has approximately 7 years of experience.
