NOTE: Amounts are inflation adjusted to 2007 dollars. The "total price" includes tuition, books and supplies, housing, meals, transportation, and other miscellaneous, or personal, expenses. The "net price" is the price that must be paid after receiving grants. The "out-of-pocket net price" subtracts from the total price all forms of financial aid, including grants, student loans, Parent PLUS loans, work-study, employer aid, job training benefits, veterans benefits, and any other financial aid received. Both the net price after grants and the out-of-pocket net price are calculated for all full-time students, regardless of whether or not they received any financial aid. "Full-time" is defined as having been enrolled in one postsecondary institution for 9 months or more full time. "For-profit" includes less-than-2-year, 2-year, and 4-year institutions.
